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## ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

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### WESTERN CAPITAL & SECURITIES, INC. AND DAVID A. PARKER SANCTIONED

The Commission ordered public administrative proceedings under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 against Western Capital & Securities, Inc. (WESCAP), a registered broker-dealer located in Salt Lake City, Utah, and its president, David A. Parker. Simultaneously, the Commission accepted a joint Offer of Settlement whereby, without admitting or denying the factual assertions, findings, or conclusions set forth in the Order, WESCAP and Parker agreed to the Order. WESCAP was suspended from entering quotations for any new securities for 21 calendar days and was ordered to comply with its undertakings to adopt certain due diligence and compliance procedures designed to prevent recurrence of similar violations. Parker was suspended from association with any broker or dealer for 30 calendar days and from certain supervisory duties for one year, the prohibitions to run concurrently.

The sanctions were based on the Commission's findings that during 1981 respondents violated the registration provisions and fraudulently omitted to provide customers with material facts concerning, among other things, the sources of DataForce International, Inc. stock sold through nominee accounts at WESCAP. The Commission also found that respondents failed to observe WESCAP and industry standards in handling DataForce transactions. (Rel. 34-24967)

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## CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

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### PERMANENT INJUNCTION ENTERED AGAINST STEPHEN E. HANN

The Denver Regional Office announced that on September 30 a Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction was entered by U.S. District Court Judge Richard A. Gadbois, Jr., Central District of California, against Stephen E. Hann of Santa Rosa, California, former vice president of Westmore International, Inc., a Utah corporation presently located in Los Angeles, California, from February to November 1986.

The Complaint alleged that Hann aided and abetted Westmore when it failed to: (1) file an annual report on Form 10-K for 1986 (violating Rule 15d-1 of the Securities Exchange Act); (2) file any quarterly reports on Form 10-Q for 1985 or 1986 (violating Rule 15d-11); (3) file any notice of failure to file reports (violating Rule 12b-25); and (4) establish and maintain records and internal accounting controls for Westmore as required by Section 13(b)(3) of the Exchange Act.

Hann, without admitting or denying the allegations in the Complaint, consented to the Order of Permanent Injunction from further violations of the foregoing provisions. (SEC v. Stephen E. Hann, USDC CCA, Civil Action No. 87-4821). (LR-11578)

### PERMANENT INJUNCTION ENTERED AGAINST BRUCE B. PAUL

The Denver Regional Office announced that on October 6 a Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction was entered by U.S. District Court Judge John L. Kane, Jr., District of Colorado, against Bruce B. Paul of Denver, Colorado. The Order restrains Paul from further violations of the antifraud provisions of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. Paul consented to the Order without admitting or denying the allegations in the Commission's Complaint.

The September 30 Complaint alleged, among other things, that Paul: financed the purchase of and trading in millions of dollars worth of securities by creating a float between certain banks and securities broker-dealers; refused to stop the practice when requested by certain of the banks; purchased securities knowing that he could only pay

for them if the banks continued to acquiesce in his practice by honoring his checks and paying for securities delivered against payment at times his account did not contain collected funds; and failed to disclose to broker-dealers his method of financing his purchases of securities. It further alleged that broker-dealers suffered substantial losses when Paul could not pay for securities ordered. (SEC v. Bruce B. Paul, USDC CO, Civil Action No. 87-1471). (LR-11579)

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## HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

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FIDELITY STANDARD LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY;  
SOUTHWESTERN LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY

Orders have been issued granting Fidelity Standard Life Insurance Company, et al., and Southwestern Life Insurance Company exemptions from Sections 26(a)(2)(C) and 27(c)(2) of the Investment Company Act to permit a daily deduction of a charge for mortality and expense risks. (Rel. IC-16052; IC-16053 - Oct. 14)

BELLSOUTH CAPITAL FUNDING CORPORATION

An order has been issued exempting BellSouth Capital Funding Corporation, subsidiary of BellSouth Corporation, from all provisions of the Investment Company Act. (Rel. IC-16054 - Oct. 14)

GREATER WASHINGTON INVESTORS, INC.

An order has been issued exempting Greater Washington Investors, Inc. from the provisions of Sections 12(d), 17(a), 18(a), 19(b), 57(a)(1), (2), and (3), 60, and 61 of the Investment Company Act, and approving certain transactions to permit the establishment of a wholly-owned subsidiary under the terms of a proposed reorganization of Greater Washington. 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## INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

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NEW ENGLAND ENERGY INCORPORATED;  
PLATTE-CLAY ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE, INC.; ARKANSAS POWER & LIGHT COMPANY

Notices have been issued giving interested persons until November 9 to request a hearing on a proposal by the following companies filed under Release 24474, dated October 15: New England Energy Incorporated - subsidiary of New England Electric System, to invest up to \$4 million in oil and gas exploration and development from January 1, 1988 through December 31, 1991; Platte-Clay Electric Cooperative, Inc. - of Platte City, Missouri, for an exemption under Section 3(a)(1) of the Public Utility Holding Company Act of 1935. Cooperative has created Platte Clay Electric Service Co., a wholly-owned subsidiary, to enable it to serve Cooperative's members and new customers in areas which may cease to be rural due to annexation by municipalities. In Missouri, the service area of rural electric cooperatives is limited to communities with populations no greater than 1,500 persons; and Arkansas Power & Light Company (AP&L) - subsidiary of Middle South Utilities, Inc., and its subsidiary, Associated Natural Gas Company, whereby AP&L proposes to dispose of its entire interest in Associated for approximately \$27.1 million, to comply with a prior Commission divestiture order.

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DELISTING GRANTED

An order has been issued granting the application of the American Stock Exchange to strike all put and call option contracts of IOMEGA CORPORATION from listing and registration thereon. (Rel. 34-25018)

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## SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

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### NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Midwest Stock Exchange filed a proposed rule change under Rule 19b-4 (SR-MSE-87-12) to implement a three-month pilot program during which MSE would require specialists in certain issues to adhere to new quotation parameters applicable to the MSE's Auto Quote facility. The proposed rule change would require specialists in certain issues who use Auto Quote to display a bid 3/8 point less than the best primary market bid and 3/8 point greater than the best primary market offer. Publication of the proposal is expected to be made in the Federal Register during the week of October 19. (Rel. 34-25019)

### APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed by the Municipal Securities Rule-making Board (SR-MSRB-87-10) amending its Rule G-34. The proposed rule change requires brokers, dealers, and municipal securities dealers to apply for new CUSIP numbers for secondary market securities when the CUSIP number assigned to the issue no longer designates a group of securities that are fungible because they no longer have certain identical features.
