
ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

PROCEEDINGS DISMISSED AGAINST THE OPPORTUNITY PROSPECTOR, INC.

The Commission announced that administrative proceedings previously instituted on February 27 [Rel. IA-1059] against The Opportunity Prospector, Inc. (TOP) have been dismissed in connection with the institution and settlement of administrative proceedings against Barry Ziskin, president and sole shareholder of TOP, a registered investment adviser. (Rel. IA-1086)

PROCEEDINGS AGAINST TOP FUND MANAGEMENT, INC. SETTLED

The Commission announced that Top Fund Management, Inc. (TFM), a registered investment adviser, settled administrative proceedings instituted on February 27 [Rel. IA-1059]. Without admitting or denying the allegations, TFM consented to Findings and an Order Imposing Remedial Sanctions which find that it violated Section 204 of Investment Advisers Act and Rule 204-2(a) by failing to maintain adequately certain accounting records and records concerning the personal securities transactions of its advisory personnel.

The Commission ordered TFM's registration as an investment adviser suspended for seven days and further ordered it to hire independent legal and accounting consultants to assist it in maintaining adequate internal controls and compliance procedures to ensure that its books and records are kept in compliance with Rule 204-2(a). CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

COMPLAINT NAMES WESTMORE INTERNATIONAL, INC. AND LARRY J. DOERFLER

The Denver Regional Office filed a Complaint on September 25 in the Central District of California seeking permanent injunctions against Westmore International, Inc. and Larry J. Doerfler. The Complaint alleged that Westmore, aided and abetted by Doerfler, filed with the Commission a Current Report on Form 8-K in October 1985 that falsely represented it included "audited" financials (in violation of Securities Exchange Act Rules 15d-11 and 12b-20); failed to file an annual report on Form 10-K for 1985 (in violation of Rule 15d-1); failed to file any notice of failure to file reports (in violation of Rule 12b-25); and failed to establish and maintain records and internal accounting controls for Westmore as required by Section 13(b)(2) of the Exchange Act. The Complaint further alleged that Westmore failed to file quarterly reports (in violation of Rule 15d-13) or a report of securities sales and the use of proceeds (in violation of Rule 463).

Westmore submitted to the court a proposed order of permanent injunction in which it, without admitting or denying the allegations, consented to an Order of Permanent Injunction and an Order requiring it to correct its filings with the Commission and to file all delinquent reports within 120 days. (SEC v. Westmore International, Inc., et al., Civil Action No. 87-4820, USDC CCA). (LR-11580)

CRIMINAL PROCEEDINGS

KENNETH SHASHOUA SENTENCED

The New York Regional Office and the U.S. Attorney for the Southern District of New York announced that on October 8 Judge Charles S. Haight, Southern District of New York, sentenced Kenneth Shashoua, a former registered representative, to five years probation to include 200 hours of unpaid community service each year for the first three years of the probation period. Included in his Order, Judge Haight directed Shashoua to turn over all assets he accumulates during his probation in furtherance of making restitution to the victims in this case.

Shashoua, formerly an account executive and registered representative at Rooney Pace, was convicted on June 5 after pleading guilty to two counts of mail fraud in connection with misappropriations from his brokerage customers' accounts. (U.S. v. Kenneth Shashoua, 87 Cr. 475, SDNY). (LR-11581)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

CHARTER NATIONAL LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY

An order has been issued granting Charter National Life Insurance Company, Charter National Variable Annuity Account (Separate Account), and CNL, Inc. exemptions from Sections 26(a)(2)(C) and 27(c)(2) of the Investment Company Act to permit the deduction of mortality and expense risk charges from the assets of the Separate Account. (Rel. IC-16056 - Oct. 15)

INTRAMERICA VARIABLE ACCOUNT A

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until November 9 to request a hearing on an application filed by Intramerica Variable Account A seeking an order declaring that it has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-16057 - Oct. 15)

THE SEARS INVESTMENT TRUST, DUAL VALUE SERIES 6

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until November 3 to request a hearing on an application filed by the Sears Investment Trust, Dual Value Series 6, subsequent series of the Dual Value Series and similar series of the Sears Investment Trust (collectively, Trusts), and Dean Witter Reynolds Inc. (Sponsor), for an order, permitting the Sponsor to deposit certain assets in addition to securities into the Trusts, granting exemption from Section 14(a), and granting confidential treatment under Section 45(a) to the Sponsor's profit and loss statements. HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

NEW ORLEANS PUBLIC SERVICE INC.; OZARK ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE; ARKANSAS POWER AND LIGHT COMPANY

Notices have been issued giving interested persons until November 9 to request a hearing on a proposal by the following companies filed under Release 24474, dated October 15: New Orleans Public Service Inc. - subsidiary of Middle South Utilities, Inc., to issue and sell up to \$50 million of its Rate Recovery General and Refunding Mortgage Bonds; Ozark Electric Cooperative - of Mount Vernon, Missouri, for an exemption under Section 3(a)(1) of the Public Utility Holding Company Act of 1935. Cooperative has created Ozark Electric Service Co., a wholly-owned subsidiary, to enable it to serve Cooperative's members and new customers in areas which may cease to be rural due to annexation by municipalities. In Missouri, the service area of rural electric cooperatives is limited to communities with populations no greater than 1,500 persons; and Arkansas Power & Light Company - subsidiary of Middle South Utilities, Inc., to amend its nuclear fuel leasing agreement, and to consent to a related credit agreement.
