CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

COMPLAINT NAMES SHIMON LEV

The Commission filed a Complaint on October 22 seeking injunctive and other equitable relief in the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of New York against Shimon Lev. The Complaint alleges that Lev violated the antifraud provisions of the securities laws by trading in the options of Colt Industries, Inc. while in possession of material non-public information concerning a proposed recapitalization obtained from his relative, Israel Grossman. [In a separate pending action, the Commission alleged the same violations against Grossman and others. Grossman was convicted of these violations in a criminal action on August 18 and has been sentenced to two years imprisonment.] (SEC v. Shimon Lev, USDC SDNY, Civil Action No. 87 CIV 7520). INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

THE THAI FUND, INC.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until November 16 to request a hearing on an application filed by the Thai Fund, Inc., a closed-end fund, for an order exempting it from the provisions of Section 12(d)(1)(A) of the Investment Company Act to permit the Fund to purchase beneficial interests in an investment pool in Thailand which invests exclusively in equity securities of Thai companies. 5600, INC.
