## COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

### ADDITION TO WEEKLY CALENDAR

On Wednesday, November 11, Commissioner Joseph Grundfest will address the Chartered Association of Certified Accountants, City Association Lecture, at the Butchers Hall in London, England. The topic of his address will be "Regulating the International Capital Markets: A New World and A New Perspective."

On Thursday, November 12, Commissioner Grundfest will lead a seminar for compliance officers and/or their representatives from various financial institutions at Lincoln's Inn Fields, London, England. The topic of the seminar will be "Regulation of Financial Services: The U.S. and U.K. Experience."

## ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

### EVANS TRADING CO., INC. REVOKED AND ELVYN EVANS BARRED

The Commission instituted public administrative proceedings against Evans Trading Co., Inc., a registered broker-dealer, and its president and sole shareholder, Elvyn Q. Evans. The Order for Proceedings alleges that Evans misappropriated customer funds and falsified confirmations. As a result, they violated and aided and abetted violations of the antifraud, net capital, customer reserve, and books and records provisions. The Order also found that Orders of Permanent Injunction were entered in the U.S. District Court for the Northern District of Illinois enjoining the respondents from further violations of the above provisions. Simultaneously, the Commission accepted Evans Trading's and Evans' Offer of Settlement. Evans consented to a permanent bar from association with any broker, dealer, investment adviser, investment company, or municipal securities dealer, and Evans Trading consented to a revocation. ## CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

### PERMANENT INJUNCTION ENTERED AGAINST MARVIN T. RICHMOND

The Boston Regional Office announced that on October 30 the U.S. District Court for the District of Connecticut entered a Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction against Marvin T. Richmond of Scottsdale, Arizona. The Judgment enjoins Richmond from future violations of the antifraud provisions of the securities laws. Richmond consented to the injunction without admitting or denying the allegations of the Complaint.

The March 14, 1986 Complaint alleges, among other things, that Richmond participated in the fraudulent closing of a best efforts, "mini-maxi", securities offering of The Electronics Warehouse, Inc. by substituting lenders for bona fide purchasers to make it appear that the minimum amount had been raised. The remaining defendant is the underwriter's counsel, William A. Calvo, III, of Fort Lauderdale, Florida. (SEC v. The Electronics Warehouse, Inc., et al., D. Ct. 1986, Civil Action No. H86-282, PCD). ### COMPLAINT AMENDED CONCERNING JOHN J. CONNOLY

The Commission amended its Complaint in SEC v. Cymaticolor Corp., et al. to file new allegations against the sole remaining defendant, John J. Connolly, that he violated the antifraud provisions of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 by engaging in a scheme of free-riding at three separate brokerage firms where he has been employed, by opening accounts in the name of fictitious people, forging applications and tax forms, and transferring profits to bank accounts he controls. The Commission also alleged, as part of this scheme, Connolly has knowingly tendered checks in payment

for these purchases on accounts with insufficient funds and submitted deliberately false forms to the brokerage firms to delay discovery of his fraud. The Commission seeks disgorgement of Connolly's profits and commissions from these fraudulent transactions. (SEC v. Cymaticolor Corp., et al., 84 Civ. 4508, DNE, SDNY). (LR-11602)

## INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

### SHORT-TERM YIELD SECURITIES, INC.

An order has been issued declaring that Short-Term Yield Securities, Inc. has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-16110 - Nov. 4)

### THE HORIZON FUNDS

An order has been issued exempting The Horizon Funds from the provisions of Sections 18(f)(1), 18(g), and 18(i) of the Investment Company Act to permit it to issue separate classes of shares representing interests in the same investment portfolio that would be identical in all respects except for class designation and the allocation of certain expenses and voting rights. (Rel. IC-16111 - Nov. 4)

### FARM BUREAU GROWTH FUND, INC.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until November 27 to request a hearing on an application of Farm Bureau Growth Fund, Inc. for an order permitting the assessment and waiver of a contingent deferred sales load, and a service charge on certain offers of exchange. (Rel. IC-16112 - Nov. 4)

## HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

### PENNSYLVANIA ELECTRIC COMPANY

An order has been issued authorizing Pennsylvania Electric Company (Penelec), subsidiary of General Public Utilities Corporation, and its subsidiary, Nineveh Water Company, to lease oil and gas rights to certain properties owned by Penelec and Nineveh to Doran & Associates, Inc. Penelec and Nineveh proposed investment of capital and employees' time in connection with the proposed lease is anticipated not to exceed \$250,000. (Rel. 35-24492 - Nov. 5)
