ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

REGULATION A CONDITIONAL EXEMPTION OF GIN ENTERPRISES, INC. PERMANENTLY SUSPENDED

The Commission ordered that the conditional exemption from registration provided by Regulation A claimed by GIN Enterprises, Inc., of Salt Lake City, Utah, be permanently suspended under Rule 261(b) of Regulation A. GIN had claimed the exemption for sale of its common stock in a blank check offering under Section 3(b) of the Securities Act of 1933.

The Order also makes findings that GIN: (a) failed to disclose a conflict of interest, created by the involvement of George I. Norman, III, as an affiliate and promoter in 18 offerings, not identified in GIN's offering circular, as required by Item 3(a) of Part II - Offering Circular; (b) disclosed in the offering circular that Norman is presently involved in three other public companies as an affiliate but omitted to disclose his involvement in the other 18 public companies as an affiliate and promoter; (c) misrepresented in the auditor's opinion letter contained in the offering circular that an audit had been conducted in accordance with GAAS; and (d) failed to cooperate with an investigation.
