CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

PROPOSED PLANS FOR DISTRIBUTION OF ILLEGAL PROFITS FILED

The Commission today filed in the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of New York proposed plans for distribution of the illegal profits disgorged by the Dennis B. Levine and Robert M. Wilkis as a result of their alleged insider trading. The plans, which are subject to court approval, allocate \$6.6 and \$1.4 million to eligible Levine and Wilkis investor claimants, respectively. Under the proposed plans, government tax authorities will share, on a pro rata basis, \$4.9 million in Levine and \$1.4 million in Wilkis. (SEC v. Dennis B. Levine, et al., No. 86 Civ. 3726 [RO], SDNY; SEC v. Robert M. Wilkis, et al., No. 86 Civ. 5182 [RO], SDNY). (LR-11605)

CARDINAL TAX-EXEMPT BOND TRUST, SELECTIVE TRUSTS PROGRAM, FIRST SERIES (AND SUBSEQUENT SERIES); THOMSON MCKINNON GLOBAL TRUST

Orders have been issued declaring that Cardinal Tax-Exempt Bond Trust, Selective Trusts Program, First Series (and Subsequent Series), and Thomson McKinnon Global Trust have ceased to be investment companies. (Rel. IC-16117; IC-16118 - Nov. 10)

DAILY MONEY FUND

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed by the Pacific Stock Exchange (SR-PSE-87-14) that would amend Section 8(b) of its Rule XII to provide for a one-member arbitration panel to hear member to member controversies where the amount in dispute is less than \$5,000. (Rel. 34-25105)

NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

Proposed rule changes have been filed under Rule 19b-4 by: The Depository Trust Company (SR-DTC-87-15) which would fully implement its Tax Exempt Dividend Service (TEDS), which is now in the pilot program stage. TEDS allows DTC participants to receive on behalf of certain customers Canadian dividend and similar payments on payment date through DTC's dividends payment system. (Rel. 34-25109); and The National Securities Clearing Corporation (SR-NSCC-87-10) which requests Commission approval of its Reconfirmation and Pricing Service (RECAPS). RECAPS, a system used to reconfirm and reprice fails, was approved on a pilot basis in Release 34-24519 [SR-NSCC-87-6]. (Rel. 34-25113)

TRUST INDENTURE ACT RELEASES

CITICORP

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until December 2 to request a hearing on an application by Citicorp under Section 310(b)(1)(ii) of the Trust Indenture Act of 1939. The application declares that the trusteeship of United States Trust Company of New York under four existing indentures and two pooling and servicing

agreements dated August 1, 1987 under which certificates evidencing interests in a pool of mortgage loans have been issued, is not so likely to involve a material conflict of interest as to make it necessary to disqualify the Trust Company from acting as trustee. The Trust Company is currently acting as trustee under the following four indentures dated: (1) February 15, 1972, involving the issuance of floating rate notes, due 1989; (2) March 15, 1977, involving the issuance of various series of unsecured and unsubordinated notes; (3) August 25, 1977, involving the issuance of rising-rate notes, Series A; and (4) April 21, 1980, involving the issuance of various, series of unsecured and unsubordinated notes.
