CRIMINAL PROCEEDINGS

FORMER VIDEO STATION OFFICERS INDICTED

The Los Angeles Regional Office and the U.S. Attorney for the Central District of California announced that on November 17 an indictment was filed against Edward Joseph Atkinson, George William Atkinson, and Robert Alden MacNeil, Jr. The indictment charges the Atkinsons with fraud and reporting violations with respect to a materially false Form 10-K and Form 10-Q filed by the Video Station, Inc.; charges E. Atkinson with insider trading in Video Station stock; and charges the Atkinsons and MacNeil with perjury in testimony before officers of the Commission. G. Atkinson and E. Atkinson are alleged to have been the president and secretary/treasurer, respectively, of Video Station and directors of that company. (U.S. v. Edward Joseph Atkinson, et al., CDCA, CR No. 87-943).
