DECISIONS IN ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDING

RASKIN, ROGERS & CO., INC. REVOKED; PRESIDENT BARRED. The SEC has announced the issuance of an order revoking the broker-dealer registration of Raskin, Rogers & Co., Inc. (now R. A. Raskin & Co., Inc.) of New York, and barring Richard A. Raskin, its president, from association with any broker or dealer. The order further provides that after 12 months Raskin may apply for permission to re-enter the securities business in a non-supervisory capacity upon a showing of adequate supervision. According to the decision, respondents, between August 1971 and January 1973, failed to comply with broker-dealer registration, net capital, financial reporting, and record-keeping provisions of the Securities Exchange Act and various rules thereunder. The Commission order was issued pursuant to an offer of settlement in which respondents, without admitting or denying the charges against them, consented to the above findings and the indicated sanctions. COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

TRADING SUSPENDED IN J B & T CO. SECURITIES. The SEC has announced the suspension of over-the-counter trading in the securities of J B & T Co. of Colorado for one ten-day period commencing on June 8 and terminating at midnight (EDT) on June 17, 1973.

The Commission initiated the suspension because J B & T failed to comply with the reporting provisions of the Exchange Act resulting in the lack of current and accurate information available to the public. (Rel. 34-10215)

COURT ENFORCEMENT ACTIONS

COMPLAINT NAMES COOK & SON. The SEC Fort Worth Regional Office has announced the filing of a complaint on June 5 in Federal Court at Tyler, Texas seeking to enjoin Cook & Son Oil Company, Inc., of Kilgore, Texas, and its president, Joseph W. Cook of Longview, Texas from violations of the Federal securities laws in the offer and sale of fractional working interests and limited partnership interests in oil and gas leases located in Pennsylvania and Kentucky. (LR-5925)

A. J. WHITE & CO., OTHERS INDICTED. The SEC Boston Regional Office announced the return on June 6 of a ten count criminal indictment in Federal court in Providence, Rhode Island against James A. Noon and Allan J. White of Warwick, Rhode Island and A. J. White & Co., of East Providence, Rhode Island, for violations of the registration, record keeping and antifraud provisions of the securities laws and conspiracy to violate these statutes in the offer and sale of common stock of Develco, Inc. Named as a co-conspirator but not as a defendant was Michael J. Glover of Warwick, Rhode Island. (LR-5926)

HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

WEST TEXAS UTILITIES COMPANY.

The SEC has issued a notice giving interested persons until July 6 to request a hearing on a proposal of West Texas Utilities Company, Abilene subsidiary of Central and South West Corporation, to issue and sell \$23 million of first mortgage bonds at competitive bidding. (Rel. 35-17998)

ARKANSAS POWER & LIGHT COMPANY.

The SEC has issued an order authorizing Arkansas Power & Light Company, of Little Rock, Arkansas, subsidiary of Middle South Utilities, Inc., to issue and sell, subject to competitive bidding, \$40,000,000 of first mortgage bonds, due 2003. Arkansas will use the net proceeds for the payment of bank loans and commercial paper indebtedness approximating \$34,000,000 and to finance in part its 1973 construction program (estimated at \$170,600,000). (Rel. 35-17996)

COLUMBIA GAS SYSTEM INC.

The SEC has issued an order releasing jurisdiction over fees and expenses in a total amount of \$196,195 incurred by The Columbia Gas System, Inc., Wilmington, Delaware holding company, in connection with the issue and sale of \$50,000,000 of debentures, due 1998. (Rel. 35-17997)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

MAL INVESTMENT COMPANY INC.

The SEC has issued a notice giving interested persons until June 28 to request a hearing on an application by Massachusetts Mutual Life Insurance Company ("Mass Mutual"), Springfield, Mass, mutual life insurance company, Massachusetts Mutual Variable Annuity Fund 1 (the "Annuity Fund"), a separate account of Mass Mutual established in connection with the sale by Mass Mutual of variable annuity contracts to tax-qualified plans, and the MML Investment Company Inc. (the "Fund"), also a mutual fund organized by Mass

Mutual to provide a vehicle for the investment of assets held in various other separate accounts that have been established by Mass Mutual or by any of its life insurance subsidiaries. An order has been requested to permit the exchange of the cash and portfolio securities of the Annuity Fund for shares of the Fund pursuant to a plan adopted by shareholders of the Annuity Fund that it should become a unit investment trust investing in shares of the Fund, and further exempting Mass Mutual and the Annuity Fund from the provisions of the Act relating to the requirement that the assets of a unit investment trust be held in trust or in bank custodianship.
