HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

ALABAMA POWER COMPANY. An order has been issued authorizing a proposal of Alabama Power Company, an electric utility subsidiary of The Southern Company, a registered holding company, to issue and sell 500,000 new shares of its \$100 par value preferred stock at competitive bidding and issue and sell \$75,000,000 principal amount of first mortgage bonds at competitive bidding.
