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CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

PRELIMINARY INJUNCTION AND REPATRIATION ORDER ISSUED AGAINST EDDIE ANTAR

On January 24, 1990, Judge Nicholas Politan of the United States District Court for the District of New Jersey granted a motion by the Commission and issued an order preliminarily enjoining Eddie Antar, the founder and former chairman, president, and chief executive officer of Crazy Eddie, Inc. from violating antifraud and reporting provisions of the Securities Act of 1933 and the Securities Exchange Act of 1934.

Judge Politan also ordered Antar to repatriate and deliver to a court appointed receiver approximately \$52 million that Antar had transferred to bank accounts in Israel during 1987. Judge Politan's ruling arises out of a civil action filed by the Commission on September 6, 1989, in which the Commission alleges that Eddie Antar, Sam E. Antar, Mitchell Antar, Isaac Kairey, and David Panoff, former officers and directors of Crazy Eddie, Inc., and former employees Eddie Gindi and Kathleen Morin participated in a massive financial fraud by which Crazy Eddie materially overstated its pretax income in 1985, 1986, and 1987, and that the Antar defendants and Panoff violated insider trading provisions of the federal securities laws. HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

MAINE YANKEE ATOMIC POWER COMPANY

An order has been issued authorizing Maine Yankee Atomic Power Company, a subsidiary of New England Electric System and Northeast Utilities to enter into and borrow under an amended Eurodollar revolving credit agreement with a syndicate of international banks of up to \$35 million through December 31, 1992. NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

A proposed rule change was filed by the National Securities Clearing Corporation (SR-NSCC-89-20) to amend NSCC's rules regarding Networking in order to modify the

ORDER APPROVING PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The rule change is intended to provide more specific guidance as to the supervisory responsibilities of dealers and to clarify the rule on the retention of records (Rel. 34-27620); Philadelphia Stock Exchange (SR-Phlx-89-50) relating to crossing, facilitation, and solicited orders (Rel. 34-27621); Philadelphia Stock Exchange (SR-Phlx-89-54) to narrow the maximum bid-ask differential for certain low-priced equity options (Rel. 34-27630); Midwest Stock Exchange (SR-MSE-89-10) to exempt MSE Governors from monetary damages for breach of fiduciary duty, provided that such monetary liability is not the result of a violation of federal securities laws (Rel. 34-27625); and Pacific Stock Exchange (SR-PSE-89-26) to conduct a six-month pilot program of an automated options trading system designated as the Pacific Options Exchange Trading System (POETS) (Rel. 34-27633).

NOTICE OF IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Chicago Board Options Exchange filed a proposed rule change (SR-CBOE-89-32), which became effective immediately upon filing under Section 19(b)(3)(A) of the Securities Exchange Act. The rule change provides for incorporation into CBOE rules of its existing policy regarding the entitlement cut-off time for orders to receive an execution based on opening prices during fast market conditions.
