CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

GERALD ROGERS, OTHERS PRELIMINARILY ENJOINED

The Chicago Regional Office announced that on February 5 U.S. District Court Judge Dickran Tevrizian, Central District of California, entered an Order of Preliminary Injunction against Eurobond Exchange Ltd., a/k/a Eurogold and Bond Exchange Ltd., a/k/a EBX Trust A.G. (Eurobond), Gerald Rogers a/k/a J.K. Glenn (Rogers) and Tamara Rogers. The Order preliminarily enjoins the defendants from violations of the registration and antifraud provisions of the federal securities laws. The Order also freezes all of the assets of the defendants and requires them to provide an accounting to the Court.

The Commission's Complaint, filed January 25, alleged that Defendants offered and sold unregistered Eurobond securities in the form of investment contracts involving leveraged treasury bonds, thereby raising over one million dollars. The Complaint further alleged that the Defendants made material misrepresentations and omissions concerning, among other things, the risk associated with the investment and Rogers' previous criminal conviction and SEC injunction. On January 26, Judge Tevrizian entered a Temporary Restraining Order against the defendants in this matter. [SEC v. CRIMINAL PROCEEDINGS

MICHAEL KIMMES RECEIVES PROBATION

The Los Angeles Regional Office, the U.S. Attorney for the District of Nevada, and the Internal Revenue Service announced that, on February 9, Michael Kimmes was sentenced in U.S. District Court for the District of Nevada to five years' probation and fined \$2,500 based upon his guilty plea to an Information charging him with conspiring to violate the federal securities laws and launder the proceeds of securities fraud through Swiss banks. Michael Kimmes participated in a scheme with alleged co-conspirators Arnold Kimmes and Michael Wright involving a sham "blind pool" public offering of the securities of Dun Ventures, Inc., later known as Videorated, Inc., the subsequent resale of those securities using manipulative devices, and laundering the proceeds through Swiss banks (See LR-12257). INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

RETIREMENT SYSTEM FOR SAVINGS INSTITUTIONS

Retirement System for Savings Institutions (System), The Retirement System Inc., RSI Investors Inc., RSI Consultants Inc., and RSI Distributors Inc. have been granted an order exempting them from Sections 2(a)(19) and 17(a) and permitting certain joint transactions under Section 17(d) and Rule 17d-1 of the Investment Company Act. The requested relief permits applicants to effect a proposed reorganization to "externalize" all of the investment advisory, administrative, distribution, and consulting services now performed for System and its unitholders by the employees of the System. HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

GPU NUCLEAR CORPORATION

An order has been issued authorizing a proposal by GPU Nuclear Corporation (GPU Nuclear), wholly owned service subsidiary of General Public Utilities Corporation (GPU), and by GPU, whereby: (1) GPU-Nuclear would form a new subsidiary (NewCo), which would carry out radiological decontamination and asbestos removal services under a contract with Westinghouse Electric Corporation (Westinghouse), such services to be performed at the Bettis Atomic Power Laboratory which is operated by Westinghouse for the U.S. Department of Energy; (2) NewCo would issue and sell 100 shares of its common stock to GPU-Nuclear for a total of \$100; (3) NewCo would borrow either from banks or from GPU, through December 31, 1992, an amount not to exceed \$1 million outstanding at any one time to fund the cost of providing services under the Westinghouse contract; and (4) GPU-Nuclear would provide certain administrative services to NewCo, at cost. SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

Proposed rule changes have been filed under Rule 19b-4 by the New York Stock Exchange (SR-NYSE-90-5) to amend its Rule 80A to introduce requirements for index arbitrage orders when the Dow Jones Industrial Average declines or advances by 50 points or more from the previous day's closing value (Rel. 34-27708); and (SR-NYSE-89-44) to amend the list of rules subject to its Rule 476A minor rule enforcement and reporting plan (Rel. 34-27710). Publication of the proposals is expected to be made in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of February 19.

PARTIAL ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission partially approved on an accelerated basis a proposed rule change filed under Rule 19b-4 by the <u>New York Stock Exchange</u> (SR-NYSE-90-04) to extend until October 5, 1990 a pilot program covering five rules on the list of rules subject to its Rule 476A minor rule enforcement and reporting plan.
