OPEN MEETING - MONDAY, FEBRUARY 26, 1990 - 2:30 A.M.

The following items were not considered at an open meeting scheduled for Thursday, February 15, 1990, at 11:00 a.m. The meeting has been rescheduled for Monday, February 26, 1990, at 2:30 p.m.

- 1. The Commission will consider whether to adopt proposed Rule 52 under the Public Utility Holding Company Act of 1935. Proposed Rule 52 exempts from specific Commission approval certain financings by public utility subsidiary companies of registered public utility holding companies as long as specified conditions are met. In addition, proposed Rule 52 provides a limited exemption from the application requirements of Section 9(a) of the Act where the exempt securities are to be acquired by a parent holding company. - 2. The Commission will consider whether to adopt proposed Rule 12d1-1 under the Investment Company Act. Rule 12d1-1 would provide an exemption from the limitations

The House Subcommittee on Telecommunications and Finance will hold a hearing on issues relating to computer security on Wednesday, February 21, in Room 2322 of the Rayburn House Office Building, beginning at 1:00 p.m. John Penhollow, Director of Edgar Management, and Brandon Becker, Associate Director, Division of Market Regulation, will testify on the security of the U.S. securities markets' computer systems.

CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

COMPLAINT NAMES BOLAR PHARMACEUTICAL CO., ROBERT SHULMAN

The Philadelphia Regional Office filed a complaint in the U.S. District Court for the District of Columbia, naming as defendants Bolar Pharmaceutical Co., Inc. and its former president, Robert Shulman, and alleging that they violated the antifraud provisions of the Securities Exchange Act.

On January 23, 1990, the Commission issued an order temporarily suspending trading in the securities of Bolar and trading resumed on Monday, February 5. Trading continued until February 7, at which time Bolar requested that the American Stock Exchange (AMEX) halt trading.

Among other things, the Complaint alleges that Bolar failed to disclose that on February 2, 1990, the company had agreed with the FDA to temporarily suspend shipments of all its products, pending an agreement with the FDA to indefinitely withdraw its narrow range therapeutic drugs with the potential for serious physical harm. These facts were not disclosed to investors until February 8, 1990, after trading in the securities of Bolar was halted on the AMEX. [SEC v. HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

YANKEE ATOMIC ELECTRIC COMPANY

An order has been issued authorizing a proposal by Yankee Atomic Electric Company (Yankee Atomic), subsidiary of New England Electric System and Northeast Utilities, to enter into a revolving credit and term loan financing agreement (Credit Agreement) with The Bank of New York (BNY) and a syndicate of banks (collectively, Banks) under which Yankee Atomic proposes to issue up to \$40 million of notes at any time outstanding. Under the Credit Agreement, the borrowings will be on a revolving credit basis through January 1, 1995 with an option, subject to the consent of the Banks, to extend the revolving credit period for no more than three additional one-year periods. Thereafter, the revolving credit facility will convert to a 30-month, amortizing term loan. In addition, Yankee Atomic proposes to enter into an interest rate swap with BNY during the life of the revolving credit commitment. (Rel. 35-25041)
