J.S. SECURITIES AND EXCHANCE COMMISSION

ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

ROBERT CHESTMAN PERMANENTLY BARRED

The Commission announced the entry of an Order Instituting Public Proceedings pursuant to Sections 15(b) and 19(h) of the Securities Exchange Act, Making Findings and Imposing Remedial Sanctions against Robert Chestman. Chestman was a registered representative formerly employed by a New York based broker-dealer. On January 8, 1990, a Final Judgment was entered, with Chestman's consent, by the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of New York in SEC v. Robert Chestman, et al., 87 Civ. 7148 (RJW), permanently enjoining Chestman from engaging in certain conduct and practices in violation of the aforementioned statutory provisions and rules thereunder.

Chestman consented to the Order, which permanently bars him from association with any broker, dealer, investment company, investment adviser, or municipal securities dealer in any capacity. (LR-27735)

CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

BOLAR PHARMACEUTICAL CO. INC. ROBERT SHULMAN ENJOINED

The Philadelphia Regional Office announced that on March 2, 1990, U.S. District Judge Gerhard A. Gesell of the District of Columbia, entered a Final Judgment and Order permanently enjoining Robert Shulman from violating Section 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act and Rule 10b-5 thereunder. Shulman consented to the entry of the Order without admitting or denying the facts alleged in the Complaint.

The Complaint alleged that Bolar Pharmaceutical Co., Inc. and Shulman, as president of Bolar, violated the antifraud provisions of the federal securities laws by making false and misleading disclosures, and omitting to disclose material information about Bolar to the public. [SEC v. Bolar Pharmaceutical Co., and Robert Shulman, Civ 90-0355 (U.S.D.C., District of Columbia)] (LR-12400)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

FAI INSURANCES LIMITED

An order has been issued on an application filed by FAI Insurances Limited, an Australian insurance company, conditionally exempting it from all provisions of the Act in connection with the offering and sale of its equity securities in the United States in the form of American Depository Shares represented by American Depository Receipts. (IC-17362 - March 5)

EQUITEC SIEBEL SERIES TRUST

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until March 30, 1990 to request a hearing on a application filed by Equitec Siebel Series Trust (Applicant) for an order under Section 8(f) of the Investment Company Act declaring that the Applicant has ceased to be an investment company. (IC-17363 - March 5)

NN INVESTORS LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY, INC., ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until March 30, 1990 to request a hearing on a application filed by NN Investors Life Insurance Company, Inc. (NN Investors), NN Endeavor Variable Annuity Account (Variable Account), and MidAmerica Management Corporation (MidAmerica), for an order pursuant to Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act granting exemptions from the provisions of Sections 26(a)(2)(C) and 27(c)(2) of the Act to the extent necessary to permit the reduction of mortality and expense risk charge from the assets of the Variable Account. (IC-17364 - March 5)

TEMPLETON FUNDS, INC., ET AL.

An order has been issued under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act exempting Templeton Funds, Inc, et al. and future funds that are part of the Templeton, Galbraith & Hansberger Ltd. fund complex from the provisions of Section 12(d)(3) of the 1940 Act and Rule 12d3-1 thereunder to the extent necessary to permit each applicant to invest in equity or convertible debt securities or both issued by foreign issuers that derive more than 15% of their gross revenues from their activities as a broker, dealer, underwriter or investment adviser provided such investments meet the conditions described in proposed amended Rule 12d3-1. (IC-17365 - March 6)

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed under Rule 19b-4 by: The Intermarket Clearing Corporation (SR-ICC-89-4) to increase the initial and maintenance net capital requirements imposed by ICC on its members (Rel. 34-27744); The Pacific Stock Exchange (SR-PSE-90-1) to delete Section 10(a) of Exchange Rule IX, entitled "Transaction Charges," which is already contained in a separate publication, "PSE Schedule of Rates and Fees" (Rel. 34-27750); and The American Stock Exchange (SR-

Amex-89-29) to provide listing guidelines for new securities not otherwise covered under existing sections of the Company Guide. (Rel. 34-27753)

Publication of the releases are expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of March 5.

NOTICE OF AMENDMENT TO PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Municipal Securities Rulemaking Board (SR-MSRB-89-9) submitted an amendment to amend the proposal to provide access to the public to official statements collected pursuant to Rule G-36 prior to the time the documents will be available from the MSRB's proposed information repository. In addition, the amendment would require underwriters to submit two copies of official statements to the MSRB to accommodate the public. (Rel. 34-27751)

Publication of the release is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of March 5.

TEMPORARY APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved, on an eight month temporary basis, a proposed rule change filed by the National Securities Clearing Corporation (SR-NSCC-89-13) to distribute via its Networking Service, on behalf of mutual funds that participate in NSCC's Fund/Serv, dividends on shares held by participating NSCC member broker-dealers. (Rel. 34-27754) Publication of the release is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of March 5.

Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
