## COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

### STAFF REPORT RELEASED

The Commission today issued a staff report on recent developments in the high yield bond market.

## RULES AND RELATED MATTERS

### RULE AMENDMENTS

The Commission is amending its rules to add to the delegation of authority to the Director, Office of Applications and Reports Services (17 CFR 200.30-11) the authority to authenticate documents. The Commission also is amending its rules to rescind paragraphs (g) and (h) of the delegation of authority to the Director, Division of Corporation Finance (17 CFR 200.30-1), as the Director is no longer responsible for those functions. ## CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

### GENE KAZLOW ENJOINED

The Chicago Regional Office announced that, on March 9, the Honorable Charles Haight enjoined Gene Kazlow, New York attorney, from further violations of the antifraud provisions of the federal securities laws. Kazlow consented to the entry of the order without admitting or denying the allegations of the Complaint. The Complaint alleged that Kazlow acted as the attorney for two "blind pool" securities offerings, Green Mountain Venture Corporation and Monvert Financial Corporation. The registration statement described the disclosed officers and directors as control persons who provided the issuer with its initial capitalization. It also alleged that Kazlow solicited three friends to become the officers and directors of Green Mountain and three others to do the same for Monvert, all with the understanding that they would

have little or no active role in the companies. Kazlow and other undisclosed control persons controlled the issuers and provided the funds used for the initial capitalization of the companies. [SEC v. Gene Kazlow, SDNY, No. 90 Civ 1501 (CFH) filed Mar. 7, 1990] (LR-12416)

## CRIMINAL PROCEEDINGS

---

### LEO P. MARIANI PLEADS GUILTY

The Boston Regional Office announced that, on February 12, Leo P. Mariani of Suffield, Connecticut, pleaded guilty to a one-count felony information charging him with conspiracy in connection with a Commission investigation of alleged insider trading. According to the information, the Commission staff conducted an investigation during 1987 of alleged insider trading in connection with the June 1986 proposal by Suffield Savings Bank, of Suffield, to acquire Coastal Savings Bank, of Portland, Maine. The information alleges that Mariani purchased Coastal stock on the basis of material, nonpublic information, that he agreed with others to obstruct the Commission investigation, and that he gave false, misleading and evasive testimony under oath. ## INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

---

### TEMPLETON GROWTH AND TREASURY TRUST, SERIES 1

An order has been issued exempting Templeton Growth and Treasury Trust, Series 1 and Subsequent Series, (Trust), Templeton Funds Distributor, Inc., Clayton Brown & Associates, Inc. and the open-end investment companies (other than money market or no-load funds) which are advised by Templeton, Galbraith & Hansberger Ltd. or principally underwritten by Templeton Funds Distributors, Inc. (Funds) from Section 12(d)(1) to permit Series of the Trust to invest in shares of underlying Funds and zero-coupon obligations, from Section 14(a) to exempt them from the requirement that an investment company have a net worth of \$100,000 at the time of a public offering of its securities, and from Section 19(b) and Rule 19b-1 to permit the Trust to distribute capital gain distributions resulting from redemption of Fund shares within a reasonable time after receipt. ### AAL U.S. GOVERNMENT ZERO COUPON TRUST, SERIES 1

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until April 12 to request a hearing on an application filed by AAL U.S. Government Zero Coupon Trust, Series 1, for an order under Section 8(f) of the Investment Company Act, declaring that it has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-17378 - Mar. 13)

### ELFUN MONEY MARKET FUND

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until April 12 to request a hearing on an application filed by Elfund Money Market Fund (Fund) for an order exempting the Fund from the provisions of Sections 10(a), 13(a)(4), 15(a), 15(c), 16(a), 30(d), and 32(a). The requested order would permit the Fund: (1) to have all of its trustees be interested persons of the Fund; (2) to terminate without authorization by a majority of its unitholders; (3) to enter into, renew, or perform investment advisory

contracts without the approval of a majority of disinterested trustees; (4) to elect successor trustees without holding elections by unitholders; (5) to distribute certain reports to unitholders on an annual basis; and (6) to select accountants without the approval of a majority of disinterested trustees or the ratification by unitholders. ## LISTING, DELISTING AND UNLISTED TRADING ACTIONS

### UNLISTED TRADING GRANTED

An order has been issued granting the application of the Midwest Stock Exchange for unlisted trading privileges in three over-the-counter securities quoted on the National Association of Securities Dealers Automated Quotation System and not registered on any national securities exchange. The purpose of this transaction is solely to trade these securities as part of a portfolio transaction traded through the MSE's Portfolio Trading System during its Secondary Trading Session. (Rel. 34-27798)

## SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

### PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

Notices have been filed with the Commission under Rule 19b-4 by the following exchanges: New York Stock Exchange to establish a regulatory framework to permit the trading of index warrants based on the NYSE Composite Index (SR-NYSE-90-7) and the Nikkei Index (SR-NYSE-90-8) (Rel. 34-27796); Pacific Stock Exchange (SR-PSE-90-02) to establish formal Seat Market Procedures (Rel. 34-27799); and Midwest Stock Exchange (SR-MSE-90-02) to amend MSE Rule 2 of Article XXX, entitled "Precedence to Orders in Book," so that a specialist would not be required to relinquish precedence to a professional order which the specialist has elected to accept over his/her own orders at the same price, if the specialist was displaying his/her interest over the quotation system (Rel. 34-27804). Publication of the proposals is expected to be made in the Federal Register during the week of March 19.

### ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission has granted accelerated approval of a proposed rule change filed by the National Association of Securities Dealers (SR-NASD-90-12) to extend for 60 days the operation of the NASD's Pilot Program with the Stock Exchange of Singapore Limited. (Rel. 34-27800)

### IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

A proposed rule change has been filed by the Depository Trust Company (SR-DTC-90-03) to revise the fee schedule for DTC services. (Rel. 34-27801)

### APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission has approved a proposed rule change filed by the New York Stock Exchange (SR-NYSE-88-32) to revise and codify its procedures governing the allocation of equity securities to specialist units. (Rel. 34-27803)

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

An order has been issued approving proposed rule changes filed by the National Securities Clearing Corporation (SR-NSCC-89-22) and the International Securities Clearing Corporation (SR-ISCC-89-02) to allow NSCC and ISCC to decrease the number of days members have to satisfy an increase in their clearing fund required deposit. (Rel. 34-27807)

Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
