#### COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

#### COMMISSION NOT AUTHORIZED TO AWARD BOUNTY

The General Counsel sent a letter to Paul Ritter regarding his application for a bounty award submitted pursuant to Section 21A(e) of the Securities Exchange Act. Mr. Ritter stated that in May 1988 he provided the Commission with information concerning possible insider trading in the securities of companies mentioned in the

"Inside Wall Street" column of <u>BusinessWeek</u> magazine. The General Counsel determined that, under the Insider Trading and Securities Fraud Enforcement Act of 1988 (ITSFEA), the Commission is not authorized to award bounties to persons who provided information to the Commission before November 19, 1988, the effective date of ITSFEA. #### ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

#### SETTLEMENT OFFER OF METROPOLITAN STOCK TRANSFER COMPANY, MAUREEN A. ABATO ACCEPTED

The Commission announced that in public proceedings ordered under Section 17A(c) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, Metropolitan Stock Transfer Company (Metropolitan) and Maureen A. Abato (Abato) have submitted an Offer of Settlement which the Commission has accepted.

Metropolitan and Abato, without admitting or denying the allegations, consented to the issuance of an Order Making Findings and Imposing Remedial Sanctions (Final Order), which finds that during various periods from on or about May 1987 to on or about December 31, 1988, Metropolitan, aided and abetted by Abato, wilfully violated Sections 17(a), 17(f), 17(A)(c) and 17(A)(d) of the Exchange Act and Rules thereunder, including (1) failing to adhere to the turnaround requirements; (2) failing to respond timely to written inquiries and requests; (3) failing to comply with various recordkeeping and record retention requirements; and (4) failing to maintain current and accurate master securityholder files and control books.

The Final Order censures Metropolitan and Abato and orders that Metropolitan comply with certain undertakings which are designed to achieve compliance with the Exchange Act. The Final Order also orders that Metropolitan be limited to engaging in transfer agent and registrar functions with respect to three issues at least for two years. (Rel. 34-27835)

PROCEEDINGS INSTITUTED AGAINST BRADLEY & ASSOCIATES, INC.; MARSHALL DAVIS, INC.

The Commission instituted public administrative proceedings against Bradley & Associates, Inc., d/b/a Tri-Bradley Investments, Inc., and Marshall Davis, Inc., Denver area based broker-dealers registered with the Commission; John E. Bradley, President of Tri-Bradley; Kevin B. Waide, a registered representative for Tri-Bradley; and George L. Gore, Jr., formerly a trader for Marshall Davis. The Order Instituting Proceedings alleges that the respondents wilfully violated the registration provisions of the Securities Act of 1933 in connection with market making activities in the securities of American Pain and Stress, Inc. (APS). The APS securities are not registered with the Commission. The Order alleges that the respondents, from May 1986 to March 1987 publicly distributed unregistered shares of APS that had been acquired directly or indirectly from the president of APS through a nominee.

Trading in the securities of APS was suspended by the Commission for ten days beginning April 5, 1988 based on information giving the Commission reason to believe false statements had been made concerning claims for exemption from registration. (See Release 34-25550). A hearing will be scheduled to take evidence on the staff's allegations and to afford the respondents an opportunity to present any defenses. (Rel. 34-27842)

#### CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

#### COMPLAINT NAMES THOMAS JAMES ASSOCIATES, INC., OTHERS

The Commission today announced the filing of a complaint in the U.S. District Court for the Western District of New York in Rochester, asking the Court to issue an order temporarily restraining and enjoining Thomas James Associates, Inc. (TJA), Brian S. Thomas, James A. Villa, George Salloum, and Joseph V. Gianni (Defendants) from violations of Sections 5(a) and 17(a) of the Securities Act, sections 10(b) and 15(c) of the Securities Exchange Act and Rules 10b-5, 10b-6, 15c1-2, 15c1-8, 15c2-8 and 15c3-3. The Commission also requested an order freezing the assets of TJA, Thomas and Villa pending a hearing on its motion for a preliminary injunction. Further, it requested an order temporarily restraining and enjoining the defendants from engaging in the underwriting of or participating in the distribution of an initial or secondary public offering of securities until such time as the Defendants satisfy the Court that the they have and maintain systems and procedures in place to prevent the repetition of the violations alleged in the Complaint.
