TRADING SUSPENSIONS

TRADING SUSPENDED IN SECURITIES OF SOUTHLAND COMMUNICATIONS INC.

The Commission announced the single ten-day suspension of exchange and over-the-counter trading in the securities of Southland Communications Inc. for the period beginning at 9:30 a.m. (EDT) on April 4, 1990 and terminating at 11:59 p.m. (EDT) on April 13, 1990.

The Commission suspended trading in the securities of Southland Communications Inc. because of: questions concerning a possible undisclosed change in control of the company, questions regarding the identity of the owners of its common and preferred stock, questions concerning recent market activity in those securities, and because of questions concerning an accumulation of over 25% of the company's outstanding common stock and preferred stock by several broker-dealers and certain of their customers. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

NN INVESTORS LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY

An order has been issued exempting NN Investors Life Insurance Company, Inc., NN Endeavor Variable Annuity Account and MidAmerica Management Corporation from Sections 26(a)(2) and 27(c)(2) of the Investment Company Act to the extent necessary to permit the deduction of mortality and expense risk charges form the assets of the variable Account. SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

Proposed rule changes have been filed by: <u>Delta Government Options Corporation</u> (SR-DGOC-90-02) relating to procedures for exercise of options contracts (Rel. 34-27864); and <u>Midwest Stock Exchange</u> (SR-MSE-90-4) to establish a regulatory framework to permit the trading of index warrants based on both domestic and foreign market indexes and trade index warrants based on the Nikkei Index (Rel. 34-27868). Publication of the notices is expected to appear in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of April 2.

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved a proposed rule change submitted by the <u>National Association of Securities Dealers</u> (SR-NASD-90-6). The rule change adds a Section 70 to the Uniform Practice Code to permit the NASD to declare clearly erroneous transactions void if they arise out of the use of an automated system operated by the NASD, including specifically the Intermarket Trading System/Computer Assisted Execution System Interface (ITS/CAES). The rule change also expands the scope of Article IX of the NASD's Code of Procedure to cover grievances arising out of the operation of any automated NASD system. (Rel. 34-27867)

Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
