## COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

### SEC ANNOUNCES DANIEL GOELZER'S DEPARTURE

The Commission announced today that Daniel L. Goelzer, General Counsel, will leave the Commission in mid-May to accept a partnership with Baker and McKenzie, a Washington, D. C. law firm.

In making the announcement, Richard C. Breeden, Chairman of the Commission, said, "Dan Goelzer has been an outstanding public servant. He has served with excellence as a counselor, advocate, and colleague in his nearly sixteen years at the Commission and seven years as General Counsel. For more than a decade, he has played a central role in developing the Commission's positions on the matters of greatest concern and importance to its programs. His work has resulted in favorable rulings from the courts and passage of important legislation. The high standards Dan has set for his office have made the Commission's Office of General Counsel renowned for the quality of its work and the integrity of its members. Dan is also a gracious, patient, thoughtful colleague. I know I speak for all the Commissioners and for the staff of the Commission when I say that we wish him the very best, but we will miss him very much." (Press Rel. 90-23)

## ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

### WALTER F. KUSAY, JR. BARRED

The Commission announced the institution of public administrative proceedings under Sections 15(b) and 19(h) of the Securities Exchange Act against Walter F. Kusay, Jr. (Kusay). Simultaneously, the Commission accepted Kusay's Offer of Settlement. The Commission's Order found that, from April 1984 to June 1989, Kusay was a registered representative associated with a broker-dealer and that, on July 12, 1989, Kusay was permanently enjoined by the U.S. District Court for the Northern District of Illinois from violating the antifraud provisions of the Securities Act and the Securities Exchange Act (See SEC v. Walter F. Kusay, Jr., USDC IL, Civil Action No. 89C4000). The Order bars Kusay from association with any broker, dealer, investment company, investment adviser or municipal securities dealer. (Rel. 34-27945)

### ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS INSTITUTED AGAINST ROBERT O. BOOSE, MICHAEL T. HINES

The Commission instituted public administrative proceedings under the Securities Exchange Act against Robert D. Boose, formerly a registered representative of a

registered broker-dealer, and Michael T. Hines, formerly a principal of Mikal & Company, which was a registered broker-dealer.

The Order for Proceedings alleges that Boose was convicted of conspiracy to commit securities fraud, in violation of 18 U.S.C., Section 371, in the U.S. District Court for the District of New Jersey [United States v. Marshall Z. Zolp, et al., No. CR-86-299 (D.N.J. July 1, 1987)]. The Order for Proceedings alleges that Hines wilfully violated Sections 5(a) and 5(c) of the Securities Act in that he offered and sold 343,148 shares of common stock of Laser Arms (a shell corporation without assets or management created by Marshall Zolp), when no registration statement was filed or in effect with respect to such securities under the Securities Act.

A hearing will be scheduled to determine whether the allegations against Boose and Hines are true and, if so, what, if any, remedial sanctions are appropriate. (Rel. 34-27946)

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## **CIVIL PROCEEDINGS**

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### **MARC STUART WEINER PERMANENTLY ENJOINED**

The New York Regional Office announced that on May 2 the Honorable Kevin T. Duffy of the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of New York, entered a Final Consent Judgment of Permanent Injunction and Other Equitable Relief (Order) against Marc Stuart Weiner, of New York City and formerly associated with Merrill Lynch, Pierce, Fenner & Smith, Inc. The Order enjoins Weiner from violating Section 17(a) of the Securities Act and Section 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act and Rule 10b-5. The Order also requires Weiner to disgorge \$387,000, representing the unrecovered amount of approximately \$500,000 Weiner allegedly misappropriated from customers who ordered securities from him in 1986 and 1987. In consenting to the entry of the Order, Weiner admitted to certain allegations of the Commission's Complaint (filed September 29, 1989). (See Release LR-12261 of December 8, 1989). Weiner pleaded guilty to one count of securities fraud in the Eastern District of New York, arising from some of the acts alleged in the Commission's complaint. [SEC v. Marc Stuart Weiner, 89 Civ. 6498 (KTD) (SDNY, September 29, 1989)] (LR-12462)

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### **GOLDEN AMERICAN LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY**
