CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

COMPLAINT NAMES PHOENIX AVIATION, OTHERS

The Denver Regional and Salt Lake City Branch Offices announced the filing of a Complaint in the U. S. District Court for the District of Utah, Central Division, on May 21, seeking permanent injunctions against Phoenix Aviation, Inc. of Logan, Utah, and Carlsbad, California, Paul A. McShane, its president and chief executive officer, and Allen R. Asker, a former registered representative for Bear, Stearns & Co., Inc. The Complaint alleges that Phoenix Aviation, McShane and Asker violated the registration provisions of federal securities laws through the sale of unregistered notes issued by Phoenix Aviation and the antifraud provisions by making false and misleading statements concerning Phoenix Aviation's operations and financial condition in connection with the offer, purchase, and sale of these notes. In addition, the Complaint alleges that Phoenix Aviation and McShane made false and misleading statements to broker-dealers and the media in connection with the purchase and sale of common stock of Phoenix Aviation, which is traded in the over-the-counter market.

On May 21, Judge David Sam entered a final judgment of permanent injunction against Phoenix Aviation and McShane who consented without admitting or denying allegations of the Complaint. [SEC v. Phoenix Aviation, Inc., et. al, USDC, UT No. C-90-C-4515] (LR-12483)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

ADVANCE GROWTH CAPITAL CORPORATION

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until June 15 to request a hearing on an application filed by Advance Growth Capital Corporation for an order under

Section 8(f) of the Investment Company Act, declaring that it has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-17500 - May 21)

SMITH BARNEY, HARRIS AND UPHAM

An order has been issued under Section 9(c) of the Investment Company act exempting Smith Barney, Harris and Upham Incorporated (SBHU) from the provisions of Section 9(a) of the Act to relieve SBHU from any ineligibility resulting from the employment of three individuals who are subject to injunctions in Commission enforcement actions. The Order is conditioned on SBHU's indertaking that it will not employ any of these individuals in any capacity related directly to the provision of investment advisory services for registered investment companies or to acting as a principal underwriter for a registered open-end investment company or as a principal underwriter or depositor for a unit investment trust without first making further application to the Commission. DBL INSTITUTIONAL TRUST
PACIFIC HORIZON TAX-EXEMPT MONEY MARKET PORTFOLIO

Orders have been issued under Section 8(f) of the Investment Company Act declaring that DBL INSTITUTIONAL TRUST and PACIFIC HORIZON TAX-EXEMPT MONEY MARKET PORTFOLIO, INC. have ceased to be investment companies. (Rels. IC-17503 and IC-17504, respectively - May 22)

HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

CENTRAL OHIO COAL COMPANY

An order has been issued authorizing Central Ohio Coal Company, Southern Ohio Coal Company and Windsor Coal Company (collectively "Coal Companies"), all coal mining subsidiaries of Ohio Power Company, electric public-utility subsidiary of American Electric Power Company, Inc., to guarantee their respective portions of an up to \$7.5 million loan which may be made by Mellon Bank (East) National Association (Mellon) to the United Mine Workers of America 1974 Benefit Plan and Trust, neither of whom are affiliated with the Coal Companies. In addition, the Coal Companies propose to procure letters of credit in favor of Mellon in the amount of the loan they propose to guarantee, which would obligate the Coal Companies to reimburse the bank issuing such letter of credit, on demand, for the amounts drawn.
