CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

LEON W. SNEARLY, JR. PERMANENTLY ENJOINED AND RESTRAINED

The Fort Worth Regional Office announced that, on April 16, a Final Judgment and Order of Disgorgement was entered by consent against Leon W. Snearly, Jr. (Snearly) by the U.S. District Court for the Northern District of Texas. Snearly, a resident of Arlington, Texas, is a former oil and gas promoter associated with defendant Union Petroleum Corp. (Union). In addition to permanently enjoining and restraining Snearly from further violations of the antifraud and other provisions of the federal securities laws, the Final Judgment ordered Snearly to disgorge \$58,500 in profits provided, however, that the payment of disgorgement was waived based upon Snearly's demonstrated inability to pay.

The Commission's complaint alleged that defendants sold over \$3.3 million in unregistered oil and gas interests through the use of a nationwide, cold call, "boiler room" sales campaign. [SEC v. Union Petroleum Corp., et al, Civil Action No. CA 3-89-1502-F, ND/TX (Dallas)] (LR-12482)
