DEWANI LAURO MARINE PRODUCT DEVELOPMENT CORP, OTHERS PERMANENTLY ENJOINED IN PENNY STOCK FRAUD

The Los Angeles Regional Office announced that, on June 8, a Complaint was filed in Hawaii seeking to permanently enjoin from further violations of the antifraud provisions Dewani Lauro Marine Product Development Corp. (Dewani), Laureen M. Farley (Farley), and Robert D. Sichta, Esq. (Sichta). According to the Complaint, Farley, as the Honolulu branch manager for Royce Park Investments, Inc., a Colorado-based broker-dealer, founded Dewani and, with the help of Sichta, an attorney, took the company public with a \$300,000 blind pool/blank check stock offering in April 1988. The registration statement filed with the Commission and offering memoranda prepared by Sichta did not disclose Farley's true involvement to Dewani's investors, both in the initial public offering and secondary markets.

The defendants, without admitting or denying the Commission's allegations, consented to the entry of Final Judgments of Permanent Injunction whereby each of them is enjoined from further violations of Section 17(a) of the Securities Act and Section 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act and Rule 10b-5.
