ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

PROCEEDINGS INSTITUTED AGAINST CHARLES PHILLIP ELLIOTT

The Commission instituted public administrative proceedings under the Securities Exchange Act against Charles Phillip Elliott (Elliott), the former sole proprietor of Elliott d/b/a Elliott Enterprises, an unincorporated business with offices in Fort Myers and Naples, Florida, and the former president of Elliott Securities, Inc., a broker-dealer located in Naples, Florida and registered with the Commission.

The Amended Order for Proceedings alleges that a Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction and Other Relief was entered against Elliott on March 31, 1987, enjoining him from further violations of the registration and antifraud provisions of the Securities Act and the antifraud and broker-dealer registration provisions of the Securities Exchange Act. The Amended Order further alleges that on March 19, 1990, Elliott was found guilty of thirty-seven criminal counts including the aforementioned violations and aiding and abetting those violations. A hearing will be scheduled to determine whether the allegations against Elliott are true and, if so, what, if any, remedial sanctions are appropriate. (Rel. 34-28138)

NATIONAL FUEL GAS COMPANY

An order has been issued authorizing National Fuel Gas Company (National) and its wholly owned subsidiaries, Seneca Resources Corporation (Seneca) and National Fuel Gas Distribution Corporation (Distribution), to issue and sell, in one or more transactions, up to two million authorized but unissued shares of its common stock (no par) ("Common Stock") under an exception from the competitive bidding requirements of Rule 50 under Subsection (a)(5) thereunder, and to use the proceeds of the sale of its Common Stock to make capital contributions through April 30, 1992 to Seneca in an amount, when combined with its borrowings through the National money pool, not to exceed \$125 million, and to Distribution in an amount not to exceed \$50 million.
