COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

SEC ANNOUNCES THE APPOINTMENT OF TIMOTHY WARREN AS ASSOCIATE REGIONAL DIRECTOR OF THE MIDWEST REGIONAL OFFICE

Chairman Levitt today announced the selection of Timothy L. Warren as Associate Regional Director (Enforcement) of the Commission's Midwest Regional Office (MRO). As Associate Regional Director, Mr. Warren, along with the MRO's other Associate Regional Director (Enforcement), will oversee the MRO's enforcement program within the nine state jurisdiction of that region.

Mr. Warren initially joined the Commission in 1985 as an enforcement staff attorney in the MRO. He has since been promoted to positions of increasing responsibility, having been selected as a Branch Chief in 1988 and as an Assistant Regional Director in late 1991. During his tenure at the MRO, Mr. Warren has been responsible for a number of significant enforcement cases. Notably, Mr. Warren was responsible for the Commission's ground breaking action against the Midwest Clearing Corporation and the Midwest Securities Trust Company. More recently, Mr. Warren was in charge of the Commission's institution of proceedings against Monetta Financial Services.

Mr. Warren graduated from Stanford University in 1981 and received his juris doctorate degree from Loyola University of the Chicago School of Law in 1985.

SEC ANNOUNCES 1998 INTERNATIONAL INSTITUTE

On Monday, April 20, 1998, the Commission will host its 1998 International Institute for Securities Market Development. The two-week, executive level Institute is the cornerstone of the SEC's international technical assistance program. The program will commence at 9:30 a.m. on April 20 in Room 1C30 with welcoming remarks by SEC Commissioner Unger. Commissioner Unger's remarks will be followed by a keynote address by A.A. Sommer, Jr., former SEC Commissioner and currently Counsel to the law firm of Morgan, Lewis & Bockius. The welcoming remarks and keynote address are open to the press. (Press Rel. 98-41)

ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

PERMANENT INJUNCTION ENTERED AGAINST ROBERT SCOTT, JR.

On April 16, the Commission filed and simultaneously settled an insider trading action against Robert G. Scott, Jr. a former employee of Chase Manhattan Bank (Chase). On a neither admit nor deny basis, Scott consented to the entry of a permanent injunction from further violations of the federal securities laws, and agreed to pay disgorgement of \$12,267 of his ill-gotten gains, plus prejudgment interest, and a civil penalty of \$12,267.

The complaint alleged that Scott purchased 400 shares of Lotus Development Corporation (Lotus), a Cambridge, Massachusetts company, in advance of International Business Machine Corporation's (IBM's) June 5, 1995 public announcement that it was commencing a tender offer for Lotus at \$60 per share. According to the complaint, Scott illegally purchased the Lotus stock in advance of the public announcement after learning of IBM's confidential plans to acquire Lotus in the course of his work at Chase, which IBM had retained to provide tender offer administrative services for the transaction. After the public announcement, on June 5, 1995, the price of Lotus' common stock increased about 89%, to \$61 per share. The complaint alleged that Scott violated Sections 10(b) and 14(e) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rules 10b-5 and 14e-3 thereunder. [SEC v. Robert G. HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

**AMERICAN ELECTRIC POWER COMPANY, INC.
CENTRAL AND SOUTH WEST CORPORATION**

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until May 12, 1998, to request a hearing on a proposal by American Electric Power Company, Inc. (AEP) and Central and South West Corporation (CSW), each a registered holding company, in connection with the proposed merger of AEP and CSW (Merger), for AEP to amend its certificate of incorporation to increase the number of authorized shares of AEP common stock. An order has been issued authorizing AEP to solicit proxies from its common stockholders to approve (a) this proposed amendment and (b) the issuance of AEP common stock. The order also authorizes CSW to solicit proxies from its common stockholders to approve the Merger. (Rel. 35-26857)

EUA ENERGY INVESTMENT CORPORATION, ET AL.

An order has been issued authorizing a proposal by Eastern Energy Investment Corporation (EEIC) and EUA Bioten, Inc. (EUAB), each a

nonutility subsidiary of Eastern Utilities Associates, a registered holding company. EEIC and EUAB have been authorized to design, construct, install, operate and maintain two biomass-fired combustion turbine power generation facilities for a customer in India. EEIC and EUAB have also been authorized to engage in activities to develop and commercialize these types of facilities and related products and services for other customers, both inside and outside the United States. These activities would be conducted by BIOTEN Partnership (EUABP), a general partnership in which EUAB will have a 79.8% interest, or by special purpose subsidiaries of EUABP (Special Purpose Entities). In addition, the Commission has extended EEIC's and EUAB's authority to invest funds in EUABP, and has authorized EUABP to invest in the Special Purpose Entities, through December 31, 2002. Such investments would be limited to advances under a line of credit not to exceed \$13 million outstanding and capital contributions not to exceed \$8.907 million. (Rel. 35-26858)

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission granted accelerated approval to a proposed rule change submitted by the National Association of Securities Dealers (SR-NASD-98-02) to extend the option position limit hedge exemption pilot program until December 31, 1998. (Rel. 34-39865)

PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Midwest Clearing Corporation and the Midwest Securities Trust Company filed proposed rule changes (SR-MCC-98-01 and SR-MSTC-98-01) which propose to amend MCC's and MSTC's by-laws relating to the structure and composition of their board of directors. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of April 20. (Rel. 34-39872)

The Pacific Exchange filed a proposed rule change (SR-PCX-98-02) relating to LMM Book Pilot Program expansion to allow book staffing by employees of the LMM. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of April 20. (Rel. 34-39875)

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved a proposed rule change (SR-CHX-98-04) filed by the Chicago Stock Exchange which requires certain off-floor associated persons of CHX member firms to successfully complete the Series 7 examination. Publication of the approval order is expected in the Federal Register during the week of April 20. (Rel. 34-39874)

WITHDRAWALS GRANTED

An order has been issued granting the application of P.T. Riau Andalan Pulp & Paper to withdraw its 11 1/2% Guaranteed Secured Notes, due 2000 and 13 1/4% Guaranteed Secured Notes, due 2005, from listing and registration on the New York Stock Exchange. (Rel. 34-39876)

An order has been issued granting the application of the Boston Stock Exchange to strike from listing and registration Xenometrix, Inc., Common Stock, \$.0001 Par Value, and Redeemable Common Stock Purchase Warrants. (Rel. 34-39877)
