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## COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

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### CHAIRMAN LEVITT ANNOUNCES CREATION OF INVESTMENT ADVISER TASK FORCE

Chairman Arthur Levitt today announced the creation of a Commission Task Force on Investment Adviser Regulation. The new task force will be staffed with eight lawyers and will be part of the Commission's Division of Investment Management.

Chairman Levitt said, "We are redoubling our efforts to make sure that our rules and interpretations protect the millions of investors who today rely on investment advisers. The legislation enacted last year splitting regulatory jurisdiction over advisers between the Commission and the states provides a good starting point to take a fresh look at our rules and interpretations and clean out any cobwebs that may have grown over the years." ### COMMISSION ADOPTS PRIVATELY OFFERED INVESTMENT COMPANY RULES

The Commission has issued a release adopting Rules 2a51-1, 2a51-2, 2a51-3, 3c-1, 3c-5 and 3c-6 under the Investment Company Act of 1940. The rules implement provisions of the National Securities Markets Improvement Act of 1996 relating to privately offered investment companies. The 1996 Act, among other things, amended Section 3(c)(1) of the Investment Company Act (the existing exclusion from Investment Company Act regulation used by privately offered investment companies) and added Section 3(c)(7) to create a new exclusion from regulation under the Investment Company Act for privately offered investment companies that consist solely of "qualified purchasers" owning or investing on a discretionary basis a specified amount of "investments." The adopted rules (i) define the term "investments" for purposes of the qualified purchaser definition; (ii) define the term "beneficial owner" for purposes of the provisions that permit an existing privately offered investment company to convert into a qualified purchaser pool or to be treated as a qualified purchaser; (iii) address certain interpretative issues under section 3(c)(7); (iv) address certain interpretative issues under section 3(c)(1) resulting from changes made by the 1996 Act; (v) address investments in privately offered investment companies by "knowledgeable employees"; and (vi) address certain transfers of securities issued by privately offered investment

companies. (Rel. IC-22597)

#### COMMISSION ISSUES ORDER UNDER TRUST INDENTURE ACT

The Securities and Exchange Commission has issued an order under Section 304(d) of the Trust Indenture Act of 1939 on an application by Metallurg, Inc., with respect to an indenture among the Company, Shieldalloy Metallurgical Corporation, and IBJ Schroder Bank & Trust Company, as trustee, conditionally exempting specified provisions of the indenture from the requirements of Section 314(d) of the Act. 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#### ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

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#### JARON EQUITIES CORP.'S REGISTRATION REVOKED AND SHERIDAN MANHATTAN GROUP AND DERMOT SHERIDAN PERMANENTLY BARRED

The Securities and Exchange Commission has accepted offers by Jaron Equities Corp. (Jaron), Sheridan Manhattan Group, Inc. (SMG) and Dermot Sheridan (Sheridan) to settle administrative proceedings, which were instituted simultaneously with the imposition of sanctions. Jaron consented to the issuance of an Order Instituting Public Administrative Proceedings Pursuant to Section 15(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, Making Findings And Imposing Remedial Sanctions, without admitting or denying the findings, revoking Jaron's registration as a broker-dealer with the Commission. SMG and Sheridan each consented to the issuance of an Order barring SMG and Sheridan from association with any broker, dealer, investment adviser, investment company or municipal securities dealer.

The institution of the administrative proceedings against Jaron, SMG and Sheridan was based upon their willful violations of Section 15(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rules 15b1-3(a) and 15b3-1(a) thereunder, by failing to disclose the true owner and control person of Jaron and falsely stating that SMG and Sheridan own and control Jaron. The circumstances giving rise to these proceedings, the adequacy and accuracy of disclosures concerning the purchase, management and financing of Jaron, are also the subject, in part, of the Superseding Indictment in United States v. James W. Nearen (Cr. No 96-874, ILG) issued on April 2, 1997, in the U.S. District Court for the Eastern District of New York. (Rel. 34-38475)

#### PERMANENT INJUNCTION ENTERED AGAINST LESLIE JOHN GRAY

The Commission announced that judgment was entered on March 28 against Leslie John Gray, permanently enjoining him from further violations of the registration and antifraud provisions of the federal securities laws. Gray consented to the injunction without

admitting or denying the Commission's allegations.

The Commission's September 25, 1995 complaint alleged violations of the registration and antifraud provisions of the federal securities laws in connection with the offer and sale of nonexistent prime bank instruments such as documentary letters of credit, standby letters of credit, prime bank notes, or prime bank guarantees, issued by the "top 100 world banks." According to the complaint, Gray falsely represented that the transactions were "risk free" and would earn a return of 10 percent to 25 percent monthly. The complaint alleged that instead, Gray and four other defendants diverted most of the \$2 million raised from investors to their own uses without informing the investors.

The court waived disgorgement and determined not to impose civil penalties based on the demonstrated inability of the defendant to pay. [SEC v. Robert Cord Beatty, et al., USDC UT, Civil Action No. 2:95CV 0886S] (LR-15314)

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#### INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASE

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CHARTERCAPITAL BLUE CHIP GROWTH FUND, INC.

An order has been issued under Section 8(f) of the Investment Company Act declaring that Chartercapital Blue Chip Growth Fund, Inc. has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-22596 - April 3)

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#### SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

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PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

National Securities Clearing Corporation has filed a proposed rule change (SR-NSCC-97-3) under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 regarding exemption processing. Publication is expected in the Federal Register during the week of April 7. (Rel. 34-38453)

The National Association of Securities Dealers has filed a proposed rule change (SR-NASD-97-14) under Rule 19b-4 of the Exchange Act relating to the amendment of its margin rule, Rule 2520 of the Conduct Rules. Publication of the proposal is expected to be made in the Federal Register during the week of April 7. (Rel. 34-38463)

The National Association of Securities Dealers has filed a proposed rule change (SR-NASD-97-22) under Rule 19b-4 of the Exchange Act to amend the damage ceilings for claims under the standard arbitration and simplified arbitration procedures. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of April 7. (Rel. 34-38466)

The National Association of Securities Dealers filed a proposed rule change (SR-NASD-96-46) under Rule 19b-4 that will permit the NASD to request that regulatory information maintained in electronic form, be submitted electronically, and to establish electronic submission programs for regularly filed regulatory information. Publication of the notice of the proposed rule change in the Federal Register is expected during the week of April 7. (Rel. 34-38468)

Pursuant to Rule 19b-4 under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, the National Association of Securities Dealers filed with the Commission on March 3, 1997, a proposed rule change (SR-NASD-97-16) to revise the listing standards for The Nasdaq Stock Market, Inc. Publication of the proposal is expected to be made in the Federal Register during the week of April 7. (Release No. 34-38469)

The Government Securities Clearing Corporation has filed a proposed rule change (SR-GSCC-97-02) under Rule 19b-4 of the Exchange Act consisting of modifications to GSCC's Rules regarding comparison of transactions between insolvent and solvent members. Publication of the proposal is expected to be made in the Federal Register during the week of April 7. (Rel. 34-38472)

#### TEMPORARY APPROVAL OF RULE CHANGE

The Commission has temporarily approved a proposed rule change filed by the Delta Clearing Corp (SR-DCC-96-12) under Section 19(b) (1) of the Securities Exchange Act that will amend DCC's procedures for determining margin requirements for overnight repurchase agreements. The temporary approval is effective through September 30, 1997. (Rel. 34-38471)

#### DELISTING

An order has been issued granting the application of The American Stock Exchange to strike from listing and registration Advanced Financial, Inc., Common Stock, \$.001 Par Value. (Rel. 34-38470)

#### WITHDRAWAL

An order has been issued granting the application of Nedeva PLC, to withdraw from listing and registration its American Depositary Shares, each one representing four Ordinary Shares, Par Value 10 pence sterling per share, on the American Stock Exchange. (Rel. 34-38473)

**CHAIRMAN LEVITT ANNOUNCES CREATION OF  
INVESTMENT ADVISER TASK FORCE**

**Washington, D.C., April 4, 1997** -- Chairman Arthur Levitt today announced the creation of a Commission Task Force on Investment Adviser Regulation. The new task force will be staffed with eight lawyers and will be part of the Commission's Division of Investment Management

Chairman Levitt said, "We are redoubling our efforts to make sure that our rules and interpretations protect the millions of investors who today rely on investment advisers. The legislation enacted last year splitting regulatory jurisdiction over advisers between the Commission and the states provides a good starting point to take a fresh look at our rules and interpretations and clean out any cobwebs that may have grown over the years."

The task force is charged with implementing the recent legislation, overseeing Commission participation in an electronic filing system for investment advisers, and developing a means by which investors can easily obtain information about investment advisers. The task force will also review existing Commission adviser regulations, and develop proposals to modernize those regulations in light of developments in the market place, the investment advisory industry, and the new legislation.

Eight staff positions have been reallocated to the Division of Investment Management, which is currently searching for qualified candidates to fill them. The task force will last for 18 months after which its members will transition in an Office of Investment Adviser Regulation in the Division of Investment Management. The task force will be headed by Robert E. Plaze, an associate director in the Division.
