## RULES AND RELATED MATTERS

---

### EXTENSION OF COMMENT PERIOD

On April 11, the National Association of Securities Dealers filed a proposed rule change (SR-NASD-97-26) to allow market makers to quote their actual size by reducing the minimum quotation size requirement for market makers in certain securities listed on The Nasdaq Stock Market (Nasdaq) to one normal unit of trading (Actual Size Rule). The NASD had proposed to extend this pilot program to December 1997 and to add an additional 100 stocks to the pilot program. On June 3, the NASD filed a report discussing its economic analysis of the pilot program. To give the public additional time to comment on this analysis, the comment period for the NASD's current proposal is extended to July 3, 1997. Publication of this extension is expected in the Federal Register during the week of June 9. (Rel. 34-38720)

## ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

### COMMISSION APPROVES PLAN OF DISGORGEMENT IN CONNECTION WITH INVESTMENT ADVISER WHO FAILED TO DISCLOSE UNFAIR ALLOCATION PRACTICES

The Commission has approved a Disgorgement Plan to distribute \$224,683 in advisory fees and \$35,974 in prejudgment interest paid by McKenzie Walker Investment Management, Inc. (McKenzie Walker), a registered investment adviser, pursuant to a settlement order entered by the Commission on July 16, 1996.

The disgorgement figure represents ill-gotten gains received by McKenzie Walker in connection with its undisclosed practice of favoring clients which paid a fee based on an account's performance (performance-based fee) with profitable equity trades while disfavoring clients which paid a fee based on assets under management (asset-based fee) and allocating a substantially disproportionate share of lucrative initial public offerings to performance-based fee clients. The Disgorgement Plan will distribute the funds to McKenzie Walker's asset-based fee clients.

Notice of the plan was published on November 18, 1996 which advised interested parties that they could comment on the plan within 30 days, in writing, to the Office of the Secretary of the Commission in Washington, DC. The Commission received no comments. (Rel. IA-1635)

#### HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

##### CENTRAL AND SOUTH WEST CORPORATION, ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until June 30 to request a hearing on a proposal by Central and South West Corporation (CSW), a registered holding company, to form a nonprofit, nonstock, nonmember corporation to operate a generating station, owned by CSW and three nonaffiliated entities. ##### PARTIAL APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission issued an order granting partial approval to a proposed rule change and accelerated approval to the amendments thereto filed by the Philadelphia Stock Exchange (SR-Phlx-97-14) relating to certain changes made to its margin rules. Publication of the order is expected in the Federal Register during the week of June 9. (Rel. 34-38711)

##### PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Pacific Exchange filed a proposed rule change (SR-PCX-97-19) to extend its specialist evaluation pilot program for an additional six months, until January 1, 1998. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of June 9. (Rel. 34-38712)

The New York Stock Exchange filed a proposed rule change (SR-NYSE-97-14) relating to amendments to its shareholder approval policy. The proposal will be published in the Federal Register during the week of June 9. (Rel. 34-38716)

The Chicago Stock Exchange filed a proposed rule change (SR-CHX-97-13) to amend its rule relating to trading variations and to make conforming changes to its rule regarding when a security is quoted "ex-dividend," "ex-distribution," "ex-rights," or "ex-interest." Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of June 9. (Rel. 34-38718)

## TEMPORARY ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Commission granted accelerated approval on a temporary basis to a proposed rule change submitted by the Chicago Stock Exchange (SR-CHX-97-12) to reduce its minimum trading variation to 1/16 of a dollar for securities traded both on the Exchange and on the New York Stock Exchange at or greater than \$1.00 and to 1/32 of \$1.00 for such securities that are selling below \$1.00. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of June 9. (Rel. 34-38717)

The Commission granted accelerated approval on a temporary basis to a proposed rule change submitted by the Chicago Stock Exchange (SR-CHX-97-14) to reduce its minimum trading variation to 1/16 of a dollar for securities traded exclusively on the Exchange at or greater than \$1.00 and to 1/32 of \$1.00 for such securities that are selling below \$1.00. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of June 9. (Rel. 34-38719)
