## SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Commission has approved proposed rule changes filed by the following: The American Stock Exchange, Inc. (SR-Amex-79-19) amending the requirements with respect to closing sell orders in options which have been placed in the cabinet and which cannot be immediately executed. (Rel. 34-16483); and The National Association of Securities Dealers, Inc. (SR-NASD-79-10) which would provide that service by mail to an affected person or entity, directed to the last address of record for that person, constitutes proper notice under the NASD Code of Procedure for Handling Trade Practice Complaints. ## AMEX TO BEGIN TRADING PUT AND CALL OPTIONS
