U.S./FRENCH ASSISTANCE AGREEMENT ENTERS INTO FORCE

Chairman Breeden and President Jean Saint-Geours of the Commission des Operations de Bourse (COB) exchanged letters which brought into force the SEC-COB Administrative Agreement (Agreement) on January 31, 1991. (Press Rel. 91-8)

Orders have been issued under Section 8(f) of the Investment Company Act declaring that FIRST INVESTORS QUALIFIED DIVIDEND FUND, INC., THE GROWTH FUND OF FLORIDA, INC., CRUSADER INCOME SHARES, INC., ALPINE INCOME SHARES, INC. and RHENUS INCOME SHARES, INC. have ceased to be investment companies. (Rels. IC-17966 and IC-17973 - January 30; IC-17976, IC-17977 and 17978 - January 31, respectively)

GENERAL CINEMA CORPORATION

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until February 26, 1991 to request a hearing on an application filed by General Cinema Corporation for a conditional order under Sections 6(c) and 6(e) of the Investment Company Act exempting applicant from all of the provisions of the Act, except Sections 9, 36, 37, and, subject to certain exceptions, Sections 17(a), 17(d), 17(e) and 17(f). The requested relief would exempt the applicant until September 30, 1991 or until the applicant would no longer be considered an investment company under the Act, whichever period is shorter. (Rel. IC-17967 - January 30)

BAIRD CAPITAL DEVELOPMENT FUND

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until February 26, 1991 to request a hearing on an application filed by Baird Capital Development Fund, Inc. and Baird Blue Chip Fund, Inc. for an order under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act granting an exemption from Sections 2(a)(32), 2(a)(35), 22(c) and 22(d) of the Act and Rule 22c-1 thereunder. The requested relief would permit each applicant to impose a contingent deferred sales load on certain redemptions of its shares with respect to which its front-end sales load was initially waived. (Rel. IC-17968 - January 30)

THE REVERE FUND

A conditional order has been issued under Section 57(i) of the Investment Company Act and Rule 17d-1 thereunder on an application filed by The Revere Fund, Inc., Revere Capital Corporation and Sunwestern Advisors, L.P., to permit certain co-investments otherwise prohibited by Section 57(a)(4). (Rel. IC-17969 - January 30)

JOHN HANCOCK BOND TRUST

An order has been issued under Section 17(d) and Rule 17d-1 permitting various existing and future investment companies advised by John Hancock Advisers, Inc. to deposit their daily uninvested cash balances into a joint trading account to be used for investments in repurchase agreements. (Rel. IC-17970 - January 30)

GATEWAY MORTGAGE ACCEPTANCE CORPORATION

A conditional order has been issued under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act on an application filed by Gateway Mortgage Acceptance Corporation exempting it from all provisions of the Act in connection with the issuance and sale of collateralized mortgage obligations and residual interests relating thereto, and the election of REMIC status. (Rel. IC-17971 - January 30)

ADVANTAGE GOVERNMENT SECURITIES FUND

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until February 26, 1991 to request a hearing on an application filed by Advantage Government Securities Fund, et al. for an order under Section 17(d) of the Investment Company Act and Rule 17d-1 thereunder that would permit certain investment companies to deposit uninvested cash balances into a single joint account to be used to enter into repurchase agreements. (Rel. IC-17972 - January 30)

THE BOING GERMANY PERFORMANCE FUND

A conditional order under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act has been issued on an application filed by The Boing Germany Performance Fund, Inc. The order grants an exemption from the provisions of Section 12(d)(3) of the Act and Rule 12d3-1 thereunder to the extent necessary to permit the applicant to invest in equity or convertible debt securities issued by foreign issuers that derived more than 15% of their gross revenues from their activities as a broker, dealer, underwriter, or investment adviser, provided such investments meet the conditions described in proposed amended Rule 12d3-1. (Rel. IC-17974; International Series Rel. No. 226 - January 31)

GATEWAY TAX CREDIT FUND II

An order has been issued under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act on an application filed by Gateway Tax Credit Fund II Ltd. (Partnership), a limited partnership organized to invest in other limited partnerships which will own and operate low and moderate income multi-family housing, and RJ Credit Partners, Inc., the Partnership's managing general partner, exempting the Partnership from all provisions of the Act. (Rel. IC-17975 - January 31)

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

PARTIAL APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission partially approved a proposed rule change filed under Rule 19b-4 of the Securities Exchange Act by the Philadelphia Stock Exchange (SR-PHLX-90-28) to modify the procedure for changes or corrections by PHLX members of material terms to a cleared options transaction. Publication of the approval is expected in the Federal Register during the week of February 4. (Rel. 34-28834)

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Commission has approved proposed rule changes submitted under Rule 19b-4 of the Securities Exchange Act by the following: Options Clearing Corporation (SR-OCC-90-08) for a pilot program that will allow the OCC to offer its clearing members on-line access to clearing reports. The on-line system is an enhancement to OCC's existing communications system (Rel. 34-28836); and Pacific Stock Exchange (SR-PSE-87-19) to adopt on a permanent basis the PSE's pilot program governing the appointment and registration of specialist units, the evaluation of specialist performance, and the allocation and reallocation of specialty stocks (Rel. 34-28843). Publication of the proposals is expected in the Federal Register during the week of February 4.

ACCELERATED TEMPORARY APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission granted accelerated temporary approval to a proposed rule change filed by the New York Stock Exchange (SR-NYSE-91-06) under Rule 19b-4 of the Securities Exchange Act to extend the effectiveness of NYSE Rules 805 and 806, which relate to order priority and precedence and proprietary facilitation procedures for basket trading, until July 31, 1991. (Rel. 34-28840)

EXTENSION OF EXEMPTION RELATING TO BASKET TRADING

The Commission extended an exemption requested by the New York Stock Exchange (SR-NYSE-91-06) relating to "Exchange Stock Portfolios" (ESPs). Specifically, the Commission granted an extension through July 31, 1991 of an exemption from the Rule 11Aa3-1 requirement to disseminate on a consolidated basis the total trading volume for each component stock in ESP transactions. Publication of the order in the Federal Register is expected during the week of February 4. (Rel. 34-28841)

Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
