COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

INVESTOR CHOICE AMONG ARBITRATION FORUMS

The Division of Market Regulation has made public an exchange of correspondence between the Division, the stock exchanges, the National Association of Securities Dealers and the Municipal Securities Rulemaking Board (SROs) regarding the scope of investor choice among arbitration facilities. The letters discuss possible action to expand investor access to arbitration forums other than those administered by the SROs, such as the forum provided by the American Arbitration Association, in addition to those of the SROs. The response of the New York Stock Exchange announces a pilot program involving five major broker-dealers that would permit access to a non-SRO forum on a case-by-case basis. Copies of the correspondence may be obtained through the Commission's Public Reference Room.

CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

The Commission announced today the filing of a Complaint in the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of New York against Robert F. Hoogstraten (Hoogstraten), Theo Willard (Willard) and Effectenkantoor Willard, B.V. (EW). The Complaint alleges that each defendant violated Sections 10(b) and 14(e) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rules 10b-5 and 14e-3 thereunder in connection with trading in the common stock of Ungermann-Bass, Inc. Defendants Hoogstraten, Willard and EW, without admitting or denying the allegations in the complaint, have agreed to the entry of judgments enjoining them from further violations of Sections 10(b) and 14(e), and defendants Hoogstraten and Willard have agreed to disgorge an aggregate of \$142,160.50 and to pay penalties totalling \$83,000 to the United States Treasury. Companies and individuals must report to the Commission within ten days on Schedule 13D if after the acquisition of equity securities of a public company their beneficial interest therein exceeds five percent. Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
