CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

CIVIL ACTION AGAINST BURTON SUGARMAN

The Commission today filed a complaint in the U.S. District Court for the District of Columbia against Burton R. Sugarman (Sugarman) alleging that Sugarman failed to timely disclose his plan to acquire control of Rally's, Inc. (Rally's) during Rally's initial public offering (IPO), in violation of Section 17(a)(2) of the Securities Act of 1933 (Securities Act).

The complaint alleges that on October 12, 1989, shortly after Rally's IPO registration statement had been declared effective, Sugarman, a director of Rally's, formed a partnership to purchase Rally's stock as part of a plan to acquire control of Rally's. Between October 13 and October 20, 1989, Sugarman caused the partnership to purchase 1.16 million of the 1.745 million shares offered in Rally's IPO. On October 20, 1989, a Schedule 13D was filed disclosing for the first time the formation of the partnership.

Without admitting or denying the allegations of the complaint, Sugarman consented to a permanent injunction prohibiting him from violating Section 17(a)(2) of the Securities Act and to pay the sum of \$556,522.00, representing monies saved by Sugarman as a result of his failure to timely disclose his control intent plus prejudgment interest in the amount of \$63,333.00. HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

THE SOUTHERN COMPANY

The Southern Company (Southern), a registered holding company, and its wholly owned subsidiary service company, Southern Nuclear Operating Company, Inc. (SONOPCO), have been issued an order authorizing financing. Advances to SONOPCO of up to \$10 million through March 31, 1993 may be made by Southern or other lenders. Up to \$5 million of Southern's advances may be converted into capital contributions or common stock of SONOPCO. (Rel. 35-25350)
