ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

SANCTION IMPOSED ON ROBERT GLEAVE

An Initial Decision by Judge Brenda P. Murray found that it is in the public interest to bar Robert C. Gleave from being associated with a broker or dealer. An FBI undercover operation in Salt Lake City in 1988 revealed Mr. Gleave's illegal activities in connection with listing Protecto Industries, Inc. on the over-the-counter market and in manipulating the value of Protecto securities. Judge Murray found that Mr. Gleave had willfully violated Sections 17(a) and 5(c) of the Securities Act of 1933, Section 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rule 10b-5 thereunder. These same actions were the basis of Mr. Gleave's guilty plea in 1989 in the United States District Court for the District of Utah to securities fraud, conspiracy to commit securities fraud, and aiding and abetting securities fraud. In 1990, Mr. Gleave consented to the entry of a permanent injunction prohibiting violations of the statutory sections at issue in the administrative proceeding. (Initial Decision Release No. 22)

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Participants Trust Company filed a proposed rule change (SR-PTC-91-11) to consolidate in one centralized manual called the "Participants Operating Guide" daily operating practices and procedures governing transactions between PTC and its Participants. Publication of the proposal was expected in the Federal Register during the week of July 29. (Rel. 34-29532)

The American Stock Exchange filed a proposed rule change (SR-AMEX-91-18) under Rule 19b-4. The rule change would reduce the Major Market Index (XMI) to one-half its present value by doubling the divisor used in calculating the Index and would amend Amex Rule 904C to increase the XMI's position and exercise limits. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of August 12. (Rel. 34-29534)

The Commission has issued an order under the Trust Indenture Act granting an application by Integrated Resources, Inc. (Company). The Company applied for a finding that the trusteeship of Shawmut Bank N.A. (Shawmut) under four indentures of the Company is not so likely to involve a material conflict of interest as to make it necessary in the public interest or for the protection of investors to disqualify Shawmut from acting as trustee under each such indenture. The Commission has issued an order under the Trust Indenture Act granting an application by Integrated Resources, Inc. (Company). The Company applied for a finding that the trusteeship of Connecticut National Bank (Connecticut) under four indentures of the Company is not so likely to involve a material conflict of interest as to make it necessary in the public interest or for the protection of investors to disqualify Connecticut from acting as trustee under each such indenture. Companies and individuals must report to the Commission within ten days on Schedule 13D if after the acquisition of equity securities of a public company their beneficial interest therein exceeds five percent. Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
