ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

NASD ACTION AGAINST ARTHUR LEWIS AFFIRMED

The Commission has affirmed sanctions imposed by the NASD on Arthur Joseph Lewis of Beaverton, Oregon, a former salesman for an NASD member firm. The NASD censured Lewis, suspended him from association with any NASD member for one year and fined him \$25,000.

The Commission affirmed NASD findings that Lewis made unsuitable securities recommendations to a customer, an elderly widow. In affirming the NASD's sanctions, the Commission stated, "Lewis's recommendations were based in large measure, if not completely, on the sheer fact of [his customer's] wealth. This attitude displayed a total neglect of the obligations of a professional counselor seeking his customer's best interests." (Rel. 34-29794)

NASD ACTION AGAINST THE CAMBRIDGE GROUP, INC., ITS OFFICERS AND LAWRENCE HOLD AFFIRMED

The Commission has affirmed disciplinary action taken by the NASD against The Cambridge Group, Inc., of Los Angeles, a former NASD member firm. The action was also taken against Donald Patrick Hatley, its president, Wendy Jay Seretan, an executive vice president, (Cambridge respondents) and Lawrence Jay Hold of Santa Monica, California, a former registered representative of another NASD member firm. The NASD censured the Cambridge respondents and fined them \$55,000, jointly and severally. It censured Hold, suspended him from association with any member for three months and fined him \$64,000.

The Commission affirmed NASD findings that the Cambridge respondents improperly permitted Hold to solicit securities business for Cambridge when he was not registered with the NASD as a representative of that firm. The Commission also affirmed NASD

findings that Hold engaged in private securities transactions outside the scope of his employment without giving the firm that employed him prior written notification as required.

In affirming the sanctions assessed by the NASD, the Commission pointed out that so-called private securities transactions by a salesman carry the potential for substantial harm to both public investors and securities firms. In addition, the Commission noted that the requirement that a firm register its associated persons provides an important safeguard for protecting the investing public. (Rel. 34-29795)

CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

ALLURE COSMETICS, LTD. ENJOINED

On October 11, the Commission announced that the District Court for the District of New Jersey has entered a permanent injunction by consent against Allure Cosmetics, Ltd. (Allure) with respect to future violations of Section 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1933 (Securities Act) and Rule 463 promulgated under the Securities Act. Allure was also enjoined from future violations of Sections 10(b), 13(a) and 13(b)(2) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (Exchange Act) and Rules 10b-5, 12b-20, 13a-1, 13a-11 and 13a-13 promulgated thereunder. Allure consented to the entry of the permanent injunction without admitting or denying the allegations of the Commission's complaint.

The complaint alleged, among other things, that Allure and Kurt Tauss, Allure's previous President and Chairman of the Board, committed violations of antifraud provisions of the Securities Act and the Exchange Act. The violations occurred when Tauss failed to make certain disclosures in the registration statement for an initial public offering of Allure common stock in August 1986, and in certain subsequent filings with the Commission. Tauss did not disclose that a substantial portion of the proceeds of the offering would be used to make payments to Tauss and The Make-Up Center of 55th Street, Ltd., an entity controlled by Tauss. SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Commission approved a proposed rule change submitted by the National Association of Securities Dealers (SR-NASD-90-33) to establish a two-year pilot program of the NASDAQ International Service, which will expand the hours of NASDAQ to overlap the London market trading hours. Publication of the order is expected in the Federal Register during the week of October 14. (Rel. 34-29812)

PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

A proposed rule change (SR-PHLX-91-30) has been filed by the Philadelphia Stock Exchange under Rule 19b-4 to provide for the listing of long-term foreign currency

options. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of October 14. (Rel. 34-29804)

A proposed rule change (SR-PSE-90-44) has been filed by the Pacific Stock Exchange under Rule 19b-4 to permit the listing of a unit investment trust that issues securities based on a portfolio of stocks included in a broad-based stock market index and/or a portfolio of money market instruments or other debt securities. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of October 14. (Rel. 34-29805)

A proposed rule change (SR-NYSE-91-35) has been filed by the New York Stock Exchange to obtain permanent approval of the portion of the NYSE's proposal regarding the entry and execution of market-on-close (MOC) procedures. This portion of the proposal would provide that a MOC order is to be executed in its entirety at the NYSE's closing price and, if not so executed, is to be cancelled. The proposed rule change would also extend the pilot program concerning the handling and executing of matched MOC orders to run concurrently with the NYSE's off-hours trading session pilot program due to expire in May 1993. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of October 14. (Rel. 34-29811)

ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Options Clearing Corporation filed a proposed rule change (SR-OCC-91-15) under Rule 19b-4 relating to adjustments in terms of outstanding stock index options. The Commission granted accelerated approval of the proposed rule change. Publication of the notice and order is expected in the Federal Register during the week of October 14. (Rel. 34-29802)

MISCELLANEOUS

NOTICE OF PROPOSED BYLAW CHANGE

The Securities Investor Protection Corporation filed a proposed bylaw change (SIPC-91-1) amending its bylaw relating to SIPC Fund assessments on SIPC members. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of October 14. Any comments on the proposal must be received within 21 days after the date of publication. (Rel. SIPA-156)
