

Newly Available NIPA Tables

This report continues the presentation of the 2012 annual revision of the national income and product accounts (NIPAs), which began in the August 2012 issue of the SURVEY OF CURRENT BUSINESS. The current issue presents NIPA tables 3.15.1–3.15.6, 3.16, 3.17, and 7.15.

The August 2012 SURVEY includes an article that summarizes the results of the annual revision followed by the presentation of most of the NIPA tables. It also includes historical estimates in “[GDP and Other Major](#)

NIPA Series, 1929–2012:II.”

Some tables from the annual revision will be published in future issues of the SURVEY. Tables 3.18B and 3.19–3.23 are scheduled for publication in the October 2012 issue, and tables 2.9 and 7.20 are scheduled for publication in the November 2012 issue.
