ANNOUNCEMENTS

TIME WARNER ENTERTAINMENT COMPANY, L.P., ET AL.

An order has been issued granting the application of Time Warner Entertainment Company, L.P., et al. (TWE) for an exemption for certain affiliates of TWE from the reporting requirements of Section 15(d) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, as amended. (Rel. 34-33271)

ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

PROCEEDINGS INSTITUTED AGAINST F. FILIPOVIC AND C. SHEETS

The Commission announced that it has instituted public administrative proceedings, pursuant to Section 8A of the Securities Act of 1933 and Sections 15(b), 19(h) and 21C of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, against Fred Filipovic (Filipovic) and Charles William Sheets (Sheets). The Order Instituting Public Administrative Proceedings alleges that from at least August 1989 through October 1989, Filipovic and Sheets misrepresented and omitted material facts in connection with their offer and sale of unregistered securities of Eurobond Exchange Ltd. a/k/a EuroGold and Bond Exchange Ltd. a/k/a EBX Trust A.G. (Eurobond) and thereby violated, and aided and abetted violations of the registration and antifraud provisions of the federal securities laws. Specifically, the Order alleges that Filipovic and Sheets failed to adequately investigate the Eurobond investment and made misrepresentations of material facts and omitted to state material facts concerning, among other things, the risks and returns of the Eurobond investment and the commissions of up to 12% that they and the president of Fiduciary Planning Inc., who introduced the Eurobond investment to them, would collectively receive from their sales of the investment.

A hearing will be scheduled to determine if the staff's allegations are true and, if so, what, if any, remedial action is appropriate with respect to Filipovic and Sheets. (Rel. 33-7033; 34-33250)

COMPLAINT FILED AGAINST MERLIN & ASSOCIATES, LTD., ENHANCEMENT GROUP, AND RICHARD GLANTZ

The Commission announced the filing of a complaint on November 29 in the U.S. District Court for the Central District of California against Merlin & Associates, Ltd. (Merlin), Enhancement Group (Enhancement) and Richard M. Glantz (Glantz) seeking injunctions against future violations of the investment company and securities registration provisions of the federal securities laws and other relief. The complaint alleges that from 1985 through November 1992, Merlin, Enhancement and Glantz raised approximately \$30 million from about 350 investors by selling interests in a pooled investment program used to trade equity securities.

Without admitting or denying the allegations in the complaint, Merlin, Enhancement and Glantz consented to the entry of a final judgment enjoining them from violations of Sections 5(a) and 5(c) of the Securities Act of 1933 and Section 7(a) of the Investment Company Act of 1940, and ordering the payment of a total of \$300,000 in civil penalties. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

THE PRUDENTIAL LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY OF AMERICA, ET AL.

An order has been issued pursuant to Section 11 of the Investment Company Act to The Prudential Insurance Company of America, Prudential Institutional Fund (PIF), Prudential Variable Contract Account-10 (VCA-10), Prudential Variable Contract Account-11 (VCA-11), Prudential Variable Contract Account-24 (VCA-24) and Prudential Retirement Services, Inc. The order approves the terms of certain offers of exchange of interests in VCA-10, VCA-11 and VCA-24 for interests in PIF. (Rel. IC-19918 - December 2)

HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

AMERICAN ELECTRIC POWER COMPANY, INC.

A supplemental order has been issued authorizing American Electric Power Company, Inc. (AEP), a registered holding company, to extend the time period during which AEP is authorized to issue and sell up to 44 million shares of its authorized but unissued shares of common stock, pursuant to its Dividend Reinvestment and Stock Purchase Plan, from December 31, 1993 to December 31, 1996. SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed by the Depository Trust Company (SR-DTC-92-11) that will codify DTC's procedure for eliminating short positions remaining in a retired participant's account. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of December 6. (Rel. 34-33261)

The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed by the American Stock Exchange (SR-AMEX-93-05) relating to the listing and trading of Flexible Exchange Options on the Japan Index. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of December 6. (Rel. 34-33262)

The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed by the Boston Stock Exchange (SR-BSE-93-5) to amend Article XIV, Section 6 of its Constitution and to adopt Article XVIII, Section 5 of its rules relating to Exchange inquiries for books and records and the failure to respond to such inquiries. IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

A proposed rule change filed by the Philadelphia Stock Exchange (SR-PHLX-93-48) to amend Floor Procedure Advice B-6, Priority of Options Orders for Equity Options and Index Options by Account Type has become immediately effective. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of December 6. (Rel. 34-33263)
