CASEY CITES NEED TO CURB DRILLING PROGRAM ABUSES

SEC Chairman William J. Casey told a group of business lawyers that tax-sheltered oil and gas drilling programs have to make economic sense on non-tax grounds insofar as the SEC is concerned. "The tax-sheltered drilling program has become a hot item," he told the Colorado Bar Association on Friday at Colorado Springs. "These interests which had once been sold by and large to a relatively limited and a relatively sophisticated class of investors were now being distributed to a mass public. My experience at the bar and at the Commission convinces me that a great deal of real money is being and will be lost in the obsessive pursuit of tax advantages."

"With increasing frequency," Mr. Casey continued, "tax sheltered deals in oil and gas and in real estate as well are being sold to widows, retired people, and others of modest means who desperately need ordinary income and for whom such adventures are usually unsuitable. That, of course, is more than a disclosure problem. It is a selling practice problem."

Mr. Casey said that the proposed Oil and Gas Investment Act legislation introduced into the Congress earlier this year is limited in scope, and that, among other things, it seeks to assure some measure of financial responsibility on management's part by setting minimum net worth requirements, and would require that arrangements between the managers and the programs be spelled out with precision in written contracts and that such contracts be approved by the holders of a majority of the program's outstanding securities.

DECISION IN ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDING

SUSPENSION OF CJA INDUSTRIES EXEMPTION MADE PERMANENT. The SEC has made permanent a prior order temporarily suspending a Regulation A exemption from registration with respect to a public offering of 150,000 shares of common stock of CJA Industries, Inc., of Copiague, N. Y., at \$2 per share. The Commission found that the offering circular filed by CJA contained material misstatements and omissions with respect to the amounts of the proceeds of the offering to be allocated to certain subsidiaries of CJA, laboratory construction, and the purchase of instrumentation; the repayment of corporate indebtedness with such proceeds; and the use of a portion thereof to make a loan to the underwriter of the offering and the risks inherent in such a loan; and that the use of the offering circular operated as a fraud and deceit upon purchasers of CJA securities.

The Commission's order was based on an offer of settlement in which the issuer, without admitting or denying the charges in the Commission's temporary suspension order, consented to the above findings and permanent suspension of the exemption. (Rel. 33-5315)

COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

MINUTE APPROVED CREDIT PLAN REG A OFFERING SUSPENDED. The SEC has issued an order temporarily suspending a Regulation A exemption from registration under the Securities Act of 1933 with respect to a public offering of stock by Minute Approved Credit Plan, Inc. of Brooklyn, N. Y.

Pursuant to a notification filed on June 25, 1971, Minute Approved Credit offered 100,000 shares of its stock at \$5 per share. According to the order, the Commission has reason to believe that: (a) the offering circular contained untrue statements of material facts and omitted to state material facts with respect to: (1) the proposed use of proceeds, (2) the method of offering, and (3) the fact that undisclosed underwriters would participate in the offering and that these undisclosed underwriters were the subject of injunctions barring them from further violations of the anti-fraud provisions of the Federal securities laws; (b) the participation of these undisclosed underwriters is an event which would have rendered the Regulation unavailable if it had occurred prior to the Issuer's filing; and (c) the offering was made in violation of Section 17 of the Securities Act of 1933.

CENTRAL MARKET SYSTEM ADVISORY COMMITTEE SUBMITS RECOMMENDATIONS. The Commission's Advisory Committee on a Central Market System submitted on October 11, 1972 its recommendations to the Commission on regulation needed in order to implement a composite transaction reporting system. Such recommendations deal with uniform rules for all markets in the areas of short selling, deceptive trading practices and suspensions of trading. The members of the Committee are: Richard B. Walbert, Chairman, William B. Eppler, Walter N. Frank, Sr., Alan Greenspan, Jerome H. Grossman, Paul R. Judy, Jack Nash, Ralph S. Saul, John H. Schwieger, Robert C. Lewis and John M. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES
