DEREGISTRATION PROCEEDINGS INSTITUTED AGAINST AMERICAN LAND COMPANY

An Order has been entered instituting administrative proceedings pursuant to Section 12(j) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 to revoke the registration of the common stock of American Land Company (ALC). As set forth in the order, the Division of Enforcement alleges that ALC has for a period of more than five years failed to file Annual and Quarterly Reports and Notices of Late Filing as required by Section 13(a) of the Act and rules and regulations thereunder. The Division further alleges that ALC has failed to make and keep books, records and accounts which, in reasonable detail, accurately and fairly reflect the transactions and dispositions of the assets of ALC, as required by Section 13(b)(2)(A) of the Act. Finally, the Division alleges that ALC has no officers or directors and that no replacements have been or are scheduled to be elected or appointed. (Rel. 34-25817)

NORMAN H. IRONSIDE BARRED

The Commission instituted public administrative proceedings against Norman H. Ironside, a registered representative formerly associated with R.L. Smith & Associates, Inc., a Salt Lake City broker-dealer now known as R.A. Johnson & Company, Inc. Simultaneously, Ironside submitted an Offer of Settlement which the Commission accepted. Ironside consented to an Order which bars him from association with any broker or dealer, investment company or municipal securities dealer.

The Commission found that, in December 1986, Ironside was permanently enjoined by the federal district court in San Francisco, after a summary judgment hearing, from further violations of registration and stock-ownership reporting provisions of the federal securities laws. The Commission also found that the same court filed an order on February 4, 1988, permanently enjoining Ironside from violations of the antifraud provisions of the federal securities laws. Ironside consented to the February 4th order without admitting or denying the Commission's fraud charges against him. The activities for which Ironside was enjoined related to trading in the securities of Gay International, Inc., a Utah corporation. (Rel. 34-25824)

PROCEEDINGS INSTITUTED AGAINST MICHAEL J. FEE, MICHAEL F. CALLAHAN AND JOHN E. KRUTSICK

The Commission announced the institution of public administrative proceedings against Michael J. Fee, Michael F. Callahan and John E. Krutsick under Sections 15(b) and 19(h) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (Exchange Act) to determine what, if any, remedial action is appropriate in the public interest. The order alleges that Fee, Callahan and Krutsick violated Section 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1933 and Section 10(b) of the Exchange Act and Rule 10b-5 thereunder by failing to have a sound and adequate basis for their recommendation that their customers purchase shares of the common stock of Airwave Communications Corp. of America (Rel. 34-25827)

ROBERT T. WELLMAN CITED

The Commission announced the institution of public administrative proceedings against Robert T. Wellman under Sections 15(b) and 19(h) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. Simultaneous with the institution of those proceedings, Wellman submitted an order of settlement for the purpose of disposing of the issues raised by those proceedings. Wellman, without admitting or denying the allegations, consented to the entry of an Order Instituting Public Proceedings, Making Findings and Imposing Remedial Sanctions (Order) which finds that on October 8, 1987, he was convicted on 20 felony counts of fraud in connection with the sale of securities in violation of Wisconsin Stat. Section 551.41(3) and 551.58(1), State of Wisconsin v. Robert T. Wellman, No. L-8475 (Mil. Co. Cir. Ct. filed April 19, 1987).

The Commission permanently barred Wellman from association with any broker, dealer, investment advisor, investment company or municipal securities dealer. 34-25828).

CRIMINAL PROCEEDINGS

CHARLES PHILLIP ELLIOTT AND WILLIAM H. MELHORN INDICTED

The Atlanta Regional and Miami Branch Offices announced that a federal grand jury in Miami, Florida returned a 43-count indictment charging Charles Phillip Elliott (Elliott) of Isle of Capri, Florida, and William H. Melhorn (Melhorn) of Fort Myers, Florida, with investment adviser fraud, securities fraud, mail fraud and conspiracy.

The indictment alleges that during the period between January 1980 and April 1987, Elliott, doing business as Elliott Enterprises, and Melhorn, the chief executive officer of Elliott Enterprises, engaged in a scheme to defraud investors involving the sale of unregistered securities. The indictment alleges that, among other misrepresentations and omissions, Elliott and Melhorn failed to disclose that securities purportedly pledged as collateral for investor's funds were being rehypothecated and falsely stated that periodic interest payments to investors were tax free.

The indictment alleges that approximately 940 investors invested approximately \$60 million in the securities offered by the defendants.

The U.S. Attorney for the Southern District of Florida, in announcing the indictment, commended the investigatory efforts of the Commission's Miami Branch Office and the Federal Bureau of Investigation. (U.S. v. Charles Phillip Elliott and William H. Melhorn, Case No. 88-12013-Cr-SPELLMAN) (LR-11782)

FREEDOM INVESTMENT TRUST
