COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

SEC NAMES OUTSIDE CONSULTANT

In accordance with the settlement in <u>Broderick v. Ruder</u>, the Commission agreed to retain the services of an impartial third party to conduct an investigation into the actions of the alleged discriminating officials identified in the court's decision. The Commission has retained the services of Joseph Onek, Esq., and his firm Onek, Klein and Farr, to conduct this investigation. (Press Release 88-61)

ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

ORDER MODIFYING PRIOR ORDER

The Commission issued an order modifying a prior order involving E.F. Hutton & Company Inc. The Commission's prior order, which Hutton consented to without admitting or denying the findings therein, found that Hutton willfully violated various reporting and recordkeeping provisions of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and the Municipal Securities Rulemaking Board in connection with certain currency transactions. The Commission's prior order censured Hutton and ordered it to comply with certain undertakings.

Shearson Lehman Hutton, Inc., which acquired Hutton, submitted an application requesting relief from further compliance with the undertakings. Based upon Shearson's representations that Hutton complied with certain undertakings, that Shearson implemented policies and procedures consistent with certain undertakings in the former Hutton offices, and that it would conduct a review of its procedures comparable to the one that Hutton was required to conduct, the Commission issued an order relieving Hutton of compliance with the undertakings. CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

COMPLAINT NAMES DANIEL B. PTAK

The Atlanta Regional and Miami Branch Offices filed a Complaint on June 13 in the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of Florida against Daniel B. Ptak, of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, charging him with violations of the antifraud provisions of the securities laws. The Complaint seeks preliminary and permanent injunctions.

The Complaint alleges that Ptak, while acting as a registered representative of a broker-dealer, obtained funds from clients by representing that the funds would be used to purchase shares in mutual funds on behalf of the clients. In fact, Ptak was misappropriating the funds. (SEC v. Daniel B. Ptak, Civil Action No. 88-6444-CIV-MARCUS). (LR-11791)

CRIMINAL PROCEEDINGS

WILLIAM YOUNG SENTENCED

The New York Regional Office announced that on June 13 U.S. District Peter K. Leisure, Southern District of New York, sentenced William Young to 18 months imprisonment and five years probation on charges of conspiracy to commit securities fraud and tax evasion. Young had previously pled guilty to charges that he conspired with various stock loan finders to divert to himself and to others stock loan payments due to M.J. Meehan & Co., a broker-dealer where Young was a former partner. (U.S. v. William Young, 88 Cr. 46 [PKL], USDC SDNY). (LR-11792)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

BOSTON FINANCIAL QUALIFIED HOUSING TAX CREDITS L.P. II

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until August 2 to request a hearing on an application filed by Boston Financial Qualified Housing Tax Credits L.P. II, exempting it from all provisions of the Investment Company Act. Applicant will operate as a "two-tier" partnership, by investing in other limited partnerships that in turn will engage in the development, ownership, and operation of housing for low and moderate income persons. (Rel. IC-16477 - July 3)

SMITH BARNEY MORTGAGE CAPITAL TRUSTS

An order has been issued amending a previous order issued to Smith Barney Mortgage Capital Trusts of which Smith Barney Mortgage Capital Corp. (SBMC) is the depositor, and conditionally exempting them from all provisions of the Investment Company Act to permit them to sell mortgage-backed securities (Bonds), elect REMIC status, sell Bonds to non-U.S. purchasers, and sell beneficial interests in SBMC and the Trusts. (Rel. IC-16478 - July 8)

HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

JERSEY CENTRAL POWER AND LIGHT COMPANY

A supplemental order has been issued authorizing Jersey Central Power and Light Company, Metropolitan Edison Company, and Pennsylvania Electric Company, subsidiaries of General Public Utilities, to sell previously authorized commercial paper through placement agents as well as through dealers.
