CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

COMPLAINT NAMES BLAINE C. TAYLOR, OTHERS

The Commission filed a Complaint on July 13 in the U.S. District Court for the District of Utah, Central Division, against Blaine C. Taylor, Ray E. Warren, Lee E. Walker, Elliott R. Pearson, Silver Baron, Inc., Gary R. Littler, David M. Lamoreaux, Warren & Brown Associates, Inc. (WBA), and James A. Foster.

The Complaint alleges that Lamoreaux, Littler, Pearson, Silver Baron, Taylor, Walker, Warren, and WBA violated the antifraud provisions, and that Foster, Taylor, Warren, and WBA violated the registration provisions of the securities laws in connection with the securities of Advanced Biotherapy Concepts, Inc. (ABCI). The Complaint further alleges that Lamoreaux, a certified public accountant in Sandy, Utah, knew that ABCI's financial statements materially overstated the company's assets and were not prepared in conformance with generally accepted accounting principles.

The Commission seeks injunctions against all defendants and disgorgement of profits from Taylor, Walker, Warren, and Pearson and penalties under the Insider Trading Sanctions Act against Taylor, Walker, and Warren. (SEC v. Blaine C. Taylor, et al., USDC UT, Central Division, Civil Action No. 88-C-619G). (LR-11799; AAER-195)

FRED C. LEE ENJOINED

On July 12, U.S. District Judge Richard Owen, Southern District of New York, entered an order preliminarily enjoining Fred C. Lee, also known as Chwan Hong Lee, from violating the antifraud provisions of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, Sections 10(b) and 14(e) and Rules 10b-5 and 14e-3. At the same time, the Court entered an order freezing Lee's assets, for an accounting, preventing document alteration or destruction, and prohibiting him from bringing any action relating to frozen assets in any forum other than the Court.

The Commission's application for a preliminary injunction against defendant Stephen Sui-Kuan Wang, Jr. was adjourned by Judge Owen until July 27. In the meantime, the temporary restraining order against Wang and order freezing Wang's assets continue in effect.

The June 27 Complaint alleges that, since 1987, Wang, an analyst in the mergers and acquisitions department of the New York office of Morgan Stanley & Co., Incorporated, provided material nonpublic information to Lee, who then directed the purchase and sale of the securities of at least 25 issuers through various accounts. Lee and Wang realized at least \$19 million in illegal profits as the result of the fraudulent scheme. (SEC v. Stephen Sui-Kuan Wang, Jr. and Fred C. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

PUBLIC FACILITY LOAN TRUST

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until July 27 to request a hearing on an application filed by Shawmut Bank, N.A., not in its individual capacity, but solely as trustee on behalf of the Public Facility Loan Trust in connection with the Federal government's loan asset sale program. The application requests an order exempting the Trust from the provisions of Sections 10(h), 14(a), 16(a), 17(a) and (d), 18(a), (c), and (i), and 32(a) of the Investment Company Act in connection with the issuance of bonds and two classes of certificates of beneficial interest in the Trust collateralized by certain loans originated by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development. Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
