COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

1987 LOST AND STOLEN SECURITIES PROGRAM STATISTICS AVAILABLE

The 1987 aggregate dollar value of certificates reported as lost, missing, stolen, or counterfeit under the Commission's Lost and Stolen Securities Program totalled \$2,765,976,343, a 23% increase over 1986. The data base, operated and maintained by the Securities Information Center, currently contains information on certificates with a market value of approximately \$12.8 billion. There also was an increase in the number of certificates inquired about that matched reports of lost, stolen, missing, or counterfeit securities, from 1,609 in 1986 to 2,564 in 1987. The dollar value of lost, missing, stolen, or counterfeit securities matched with inquiries through the Commission's Program in 1987 totalled \$9,230,307, a decrease from the 1986 dollar value of \$15,513,769. CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

COMPLAINT NAMES HOWARD BLUMENTHAL

The Commission yesterday filed a Complaint in the U.S. District Court for the Central District of California against Howard Blumenthal alleging that he violated the antifraud provisions of the securities laws. The Complaint alleges that Blumenthal, a California attorney, participated in a fraudulent scheme to manipulate the price of the securities of Hughes Capital Corporation, and seeks to enjoin him from future violations of the antifraud provisions. Simultaneous with the filing of the Complaint, Blumenthal, without admitting or denying the Commission's allegations, consented to a permanent injunction against future violations. (SEC v. CIVIL INJUNCTIVE ACTION FILED AGAINST JAMES M. MARKHAM

The Commission yesterday filed a civil injunctive action in the U.S. District Court for the District of New Jersey against James M. Markham alleging that he violated the antifraud provisions of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rule 10b-5. The Complaint alleges that Markham, then Director of Industrial Purchasing for Toys R Us Incorporated (TRU), engaged in illegal insider trading by purchasing TRU call options while in the possession of material, non-public information concerning TRU's successful November-December 1986 retail sales. Following the public announcement by TRU that its November-December sales were up approximately 26.8% over 1985, Markham sold the call options for a total profit of approximately \$40,000.

The Commission seeks disgorgement of all illegal profits derived from the alleged scheme, as well as an appropriate civil penalty under the Insider Trading Sanctions Act of 1934 [15 USC §78u(d)(2)(A)]. (SEC v. James M. Markham, USDC DNJ, Civil Action No. 88 Civ. 4167). (LR-11874)

The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed by the American Stock Exchange (SR-Amex-88-3) to repeal Section 114 of the Company Guide, which sets forth special listing criteria for Real Estate Investment Trusts. (Rel. 34-26104)

TRUST INDENTURE ACT RELEASES

VIRGINIA ELECTRIC AND POWER COMPANY

An order has been issued under the Trust Indenture Act of 1939 on an application by Virginia Electric and Power Company that the trusteeship of Chemical Bank under an indenture of Virginia Electric qualified under the Act and six indentures relating to the issuance of bonds of certain political subdivisions of the Commonwealth of Virginia and the State of West Virginia, the payment of which is supported by Promissory Notes issued by Virginia Electric and assigned to the Bank as Trustee, is not so likely to involve a material conflict of interest as to make it necessary in the public interest or for the protection of investors to disqualify the Bank from acting as trustee under these indentures.
