COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

CHANGES IN THE MEETING: CANCELLATION

The open meeting scheduled for Friday, October 7th has been cancelled. The item scheduled for discussion at that meeting will be considered at an open meeting on October 14 at 9:00 a.m.

SEC AND TEXAS SECURITIES BOARD CO-HOST CONFERENCE

The Fort Worth Regional Office (FWRO) and the State Securities Board of Texas will co-host the Thirteenth Annual Southwest Securities Enforcement Conference on November 2-4, 1988, at Bandera, Texas. The Conference is by invitation and is limited to state and federal enforcement, regulatory, and self-regulatory organization officials. Information may be obtained by writing or calling Hugh M. ORDER GRANTING STAY

The Commission issued an order granting the application of William J. Higgins for a stay, pending appeal, of the Commission's order approving a rule change by the New York Stock Exchange that prohibited the use by members of portable telephones on the NYSE Floor [Rel. 34-25842, June 23, 1988, 53 FR 24539]. The Commission's Order will preserve the status quo as of the date the Commission issued its order approving the NYSE rule change, pending completion of review of that order by the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Second Circuit. REALLOCATION OF SPACE IN PUBLIC REFERENCE

As part of its previously-announced reorganization of the Public Reference Room, the Commission said it is developing a plan for allocation of space (carrels) and telephones in the headquarters facility. Purpose of the plan to allocate resources fairly among disparate groups of users of the Public Reference Room. User organizations are asked to apply for carrel and telephone privileges by October 11. All applications must be submitted in writing to The Branch Chief, Public Reference Room, Securities and Exchange Commission, 450 Fifth Street, NW, Washington, DC 20549.

ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

RULE 2(e) PROCEEDINGS INSTITUTED AND SETTLED AGAINST KEITH BJELAJAC

The Commission issued an Order Instituting Proceedings and an Opinion and Order under Rule 2(e) of its Rules of Practice against Keith Bjelajac, CPA. According to the Order, Bjelajac, formerly the chief financial officer of The Video Station, Inc. (TVS), engaged in improper professional conduct and willfully violated the securities laws in preparing financial statements in TVS's 1982 10-K and first 1983 quarterly 10-Q which omitted liabilities and materially overstated net income. The Order noted Bjelajac's cooperation with the criminal prosecution of certain former TVS officers. The Order denied Bjelajac the privilege of practicing before the Commission, except that he may continue to participate in the preparation of filings with the Commission, other than as an independent accountant, upon compliance with specified supervision requirements. After three years, Bjelajac may apply to resume practice upon a showing that he has met certain educational and professional association requirements. Bjelajac consented to the Order without admitting or denying the findings of violations therein. (Rel. 34-26124)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

NATIONAL LIQUID RESERVES, INC.

An order has been issued on an application filed by Smith Barney, Harris Upham & Co. Incorporated, National Liquid Reserves, Inc. and other funds (Funds) advised by Smith, Barney Advisers, Inc., and Mutual Management Corp. (Advisers). The order exempts the Funds and the Advisers from Section 15(a) of the Investment Company Act to permit the Funds to reimburse the Advisers for costs incurred under an interim advisory contract entered into without shareholder approval. LISTING, DELISTING AND UNLISTED TRADING ACTIONS

UNLISTED TRADING SOUGHT

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until October 24 to comment on the application of the Philadelphia Stock Exchange for unlisted trading privileges in seven issues which are listed and registered on one or more other national securities exchanges and are reported in the consolidated transaction reporting system. (Rel. 34-26149)

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

TEMPORARY APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission extended temporary approval of a proposed rule change filed by the National Securities Clearing Corporation (SR-NSCC-87-12) that authorizes it to establish financial and operational standards for a new category of broker-dealer membership, whose activities would be restricted exclusively to the use of the Fund/Serv service. The proposal also revises NSCC's rules concerning Fund/Serv clearing fund contributions and the allocation of losses in the event of service losses or member default. The temporary approval will expire on November 30. (Rel. 34-26146)

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed by the New York Stock Exchange (SR-NYSE-88-20) to amend the applicable unit of trading for purposes of original and continued listings. (Rel. 34-26150)

NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The National Association of Securities Dealers filed a proposed rule change under Rule 19b-4 (SR-NASD-88-43) to amend Sections a) and c) of its Rules of Practice and Procedures for the Small Order Execution System (SOES) to prohibit members from entering orders in SOES on behalf of a professional trading account. Publication of the proposal is expected to be made in the Federal Register during the week of October 3. (Rel. 34-26151)

Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
