CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER AND FREEZE OF ASSETS ENTERED AGAINST CENTURI MINING CORPORATION, OTHERS

The Atlanta Regional and Miami Branch Offices announced that on November 8 U.S. District Judge William J. Castagna, Middle District of Florida, entered a Temporary Restraining Order (TRO) and Freeze of Assets against Centuri Mining Corporation, of Clearwater, Florida, Roc G. Hatfield, and William Robert Mette'. The TRO freezes defendants' assets and restrains them from violating the registration and antifraud provisions of the securities laws.

The November 8 Complaint alleges that defendants offered and sold unregistered securities to the public using general advertising. It also alleges that defendants falsely represented that Centuri's mining operation was underway using modern mining equipment, and omitted to disclose that Mette' was subject to a permanent injunction arising from his activities in a Brazilian gold mining venture. A hearing on the Commission's motion for preliminary injunction was set for November 22 at 9:30 a.m. (SEC v. Centuri Mining Corporation, et al., Civil Action No. 88-1741-CIV-T-15B, MDFL). (LR-11913)

PERMANENT INJUNCTIONS ENTERED AGAINST JOE TRUMAN SPARKS AND JERRY SPARKS

The Commission yesterday filed a Complaint in the U.S. District for the Northern District of Texas seeking to enjoin Joe Truman Sparks, former president of a subsidiary of Interconnect Communications Corp., and Jerry Sparks, his brother, from violating the antifraud provisions of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, and to enjoin Joe Sparks from aiding and abetting such violations. The Complaint further seeks \$1,919.50 disgorgement of unlawful profits from Jerry Sparks and Insider Trading Sanctions Act penalties of \$1,919.50 each from Joe and Jerry Sparks. Defendants, without admitting or denying the Complaint's allegations, consented to Final Judgments.

The Complaint alleges that Joe Sparks, through misappropriation or breach of a fiduciary duty, disclosed material, non-public information relating to an acquisition of Interconnect by Inter-Tel, Inc. to his brother. After receiving the material, non-public information, Jerry Sparks effected purchases of Inter-Tel securities while knowing or having reason to know that such material, non-public information had been disclosed by Joe Sparks through misappropriation or in breach of his fiduciary duty. CRIMINAL PROCEEDINGS

KEITH S. SHELDON INDICTED

The U.S. Attorney for the Northern District of Georgia and the Atlanta Regional Office announced that on November 2 Keith S. Sheldon, of Hiawassee, Georgia, was indicted on four counts of securities fraud and one count of mail fraud. The indictment alleges, among other things, that Sheldon, a registered representative with R. B. Marich, Inc., falsely represented to investors, among other things, that: (a) funds would be invested in the investors' names; (b) investor funds would be and were used to purchase 3,000 shares of Sea Venture Cruises, Inc. common stock in the name of the investor; (c) the investment in Sea Venture stock would net a 19.8% return within 30 to 90 days; (d) the Sea Venture investment had been structured by R. B. Marich; (e) the investment in Sea Venture stock was a "can't miss" opportunity because the stock was pre-sold to Shearson Lehman Brothers and therefore guaranteed; and (f) Sheldon had used \$50,000 of his personal funds to purchase the Sea Venture common stock and had accepted large sums from a judge in Hiawassee.

If convicted, Sheldon faces a maximum jail term of 25 years and a fine of \$500,000, plus restitution of \$25,050. (U.S. v. Keith S. Sheldon, CR 88-21G, USDC NDGA). (LR-11912)

MARCUS SCHLOSS & COMPANY, INC., OTHERS INDICTED

The New York Regional Office and Rudolph W. Giuliani, U.S. Attorney for the Southern District of New York, announced that on November 2 a 31-count indictment was returned by a federal grand jury in the Southern District of New York charging Marcus Schloss & Company, Inc., D. Ronald Yagoda, Victor Teicher & Company, L.P., Victor Teicher, and Ross S. Frankel with conspiracy and varying numbers of counts of securities fraud, fraud in connection with a tender offer, mail fraud, wire fraud, perjury, and obstruction of a Commission investigation.

The charges stem from the defendants' involvement in an illegal network that bought and sold stocks on the basis of confidential information that various co-conspirators had stolen from the law firm of Paul, Weiss, Rifkind, Wharton and Garrison and from the investment firms of Drexel Burnham Lambert, Inc. and Ivan F. Boesky & Co. from October 1985 through April 1986.

If convicted, Marcus Schloss & Company and Victor Teicher & Company would face a maximum fine of \$500,000 on each count. The individual defendants would face a maximum penalty of up to five years in prison and a fine up to \$250,000 on each count alleged in the indictment. (U.S. v.
