COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

ORDER ISSUED SUSPENDING TRADING IN THE SECURITIES OF COSMOS VENTURES, INC.

The Commission announced the temporary suspension, pursuant to Section 12(k) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, of over-the-counter trading of the securities of Cosmos Ventures, Inc. (Cosmos) of Las Vegas, Nevada at 9:30 a.m. EST on March 22, 1999, and terminating at 11:59 p.m. EDT on April 5, 1999.

The Commission's Order of Suspension of Trading arose from concerns that there was a lack of current, adequate and accurate information regarding the securities of Cosmos. Questions have been raised about the adequacy and accuracy of publicly disseminated information concerning, among other things, the business prospects of Cosmos, including its purported acquisition of all rights to a foreign pulp mill. ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

IN THE MATTER OF EUGENE LAFF, ET AL.

On March 18, Administrative Law Judge Lillian A. McEwen issued an Order Making Findings and Imposing Remedial Sanctions By Default Against Respondent Stanley Aslanian, Jr. The law judge found that Aslanian had failed to file an answer and failed to appear at the hearing, and concluded that he was in default. Aslanian engaged in a scheme to defraud the investing public during the period October 1985 through October 1987. The scheme involved the manipulation of seven over-the-counter stocks. When the scheme collapsed, the market value of the stocks dropped from \$715 million to \$71 million. As a result of his participation in the scheme, Aslanian pled guilty in federal district court to one felony count of conspiracy to commit securities fraud. Pursuant to his plea, Aslanian was sentenced to one year in prison. The law judge found that Aslanian's misconduct was of the type that flows across various sectors of the securities industry, and was so egregious as to merit an industry-wide bar. The law judge barred Aslanian from association with any broker, dealer, investment adviser, investment company, municipal securities dealer, or any member of a national

securities exchange or of a registered securities association.

IN THE MATTER OF OLDE DISCOUNT CORP., ERNEST OLDE, STANLEY SNIDER AND DANIEL KATZMAN

The Commission amended an order dated September 10, 1998, concerning Olde Discount Corporation (Olde). Previously, Olde was required to retain an independent consultant who would conduct a comprehensive review of Olde's policies and procedures and report on his findings and recommendation within 6 months of the order. In addition, Olde was provided a reasonable opportunity to comment on the independent consultant report.

Pursuant to the Commission's amended order, the independent consultant shall prepare and provide to Olde a written report of his findings and recommendations by June 7, 1999, Olde shall be allowed 30 days after receiving the report to comment on it, and the independent consultant shall submit his report to the Commission's Atlanta District Office staff by July 7, 1999. JUDGMENTS ENTERED RICHARD SMITH IN INSIDER TRADING CASE

The Commission announced that Judge Mariana R. Pfaelzer of the United States District Court in Los Angeles entered judgment against Richard J. Smith on March 17 in an insider trading case. The judgment enjoins Smith from future violations of the antifraud provisions of the federal securities laws. Smith consented to the entry of judgment.

Smith held a senior management position at PDA Engineering, Inc., where he was responsible for the company's sales in North America. In this position, Smith learned that the company's management expected fiscal fourth quarter 1993 revenues to fall below expectations and, later, that revenues had fallen below projections. Smith then used this material, non-public information in a series of transactions in which he sold existing shares of PDA, sold short additional shares, and tipped his father and a co-worker, who also sold shares. When the company announced its fourth quarter earnings several weeks later, the stock price declined.

Smith was convicted on 11 criminal counts of insider trading following a jury trial in 1996. He is presently serving 15 months imprisonment, and is ordered to pay \$89,567.58 in restitution, \$5,500 in fines, and remain on supervised release for 3 years following imprisonment. [SEC v. SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Depository Trust Company filed a proposed rule change (SR-DTC-98-26) relating to the establishment of an interface with National Securities Clearing Corporation to allow DTC participants that are not NSCC members to participate in NSCC's Automated Customer Account Transfer Service. The Commission approved the proposed rule change on an accelerated basis. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of March 22. (Rel. 34-41191)

PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Municipal Securities Rulemaking Board filed a proposed rule change (SR-MSRB-99-2) amending Rule G-11, clarifying disclosure requirements in connection with new issues. Publication of the notice in the Federal Register is expected during the week of March 22. (Rel. 34-41192)
