INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

PAINWEBBER INCORPORATED AND PAINWEBBER EQUITY TRUST, ABCs TRUST SERIES

An order has been issued on an application filed by PaineWebber Incorporated and PaineWebber Equity Trust, ABCs Trust Series 1 for an exemption from Section 17(a) of the Investment Company Act. The order permits certain terminating series of a unit investment trust (UIT) to sell portfolio securities to certain new series of the UIT. (Rel. IC-23827 - May 6)

BANKERS TRUST COMPANY, ET AL.

The Commission has extended a temporary order exempting Bankers Trust Company (BT) and entities of which BT is or becomes an affiliated person from Section 9(a) of the Investment Company Act until the Commission takes final action on an application for a permanent order or, if earlier, November 8, 1999. The Commission also has issued a notice of BT's application for a permanent order. (Rel. IC-23828 - May 7)

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

ORDER APPROVING AMENDMENT TO LOW VOLUME EXEMPTION FROM EXCHANGE REGISTRATION

The Commission approved the Arizona Stock Exchange's amendment (File No. 10-100) to its application for a low volume exemption from exchange registration to allow AZX to add two additional daylight auctions, trade exchange-listed securities during its daylight auctions, and consolidate its two evening auctions. Publication of the approval order is expected in the Federal Register during the week of May 10. (Rel. 34-41362)

ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Commission granted accelerated approval, for a six-month period, to a proposed rule change (SR-Phlx-99-12) filed by the Philadelphia Stock Exchange to set temporarily the add-on margin levels for non-customized cross-rate foreign currency options. Publication of

the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of May 10. (Rel. 34-41365)

The Commission granted accelerated approval to a proposed rule change submitted by the Cincinnati Stock Exchange (SR-CSE-99-04) amending the Exchange's Minor Rule Violation Program. (Rel. 34-41366)

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Commission approved a proposed rule change (SR-NASD-98-88) submitted by the National Association of Securities Dealers enumerating the procedures applied by Nasdaq in reaching listing, delisting, and continued listing decisions. (Rel. 34-41367)

The Commission has approved proposed rule changes filed by the Municipal Securities Rulemaking Board, the National Association of Securities Dealers, and the New York Stock Exchange (SR-MSRB-98-06, SR-NASD-98-20, SR-NYSE-98-07) under Section 19(b)(1) of the Exchange Act. The rule changes permit electronic confirmation/affirmation of customer transactions by "qualified vendors." (Rel. 34-41378)

PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Chicago Board Options Exchange filed a proposed rule change (SR-CBOE-98-50) to permit the Exchange to trade Differential Index Options, a new type of standardized index option whose value at expiration is based on the relative performance of either a designated index versus a benchmark index, a designated stock versus a benchmark index, or a designated stock versus a benchmark stock. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of March 10. (Rel. 34-41368)

The National Association of Securities Dealers has filed Amendment No. 4 to a proposed rule change (SR-NASD-98-96) to amend the Forms U-4 and U-5. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of March 10. (Rel. 34-41371)

The Chicago Board Options Exchange filed a proposed rule change (SR-CBOE-99-14) relating to listing criteria for warrants. Publication of the notice in the Federal Register is expected during the week of March 10. (Rel. 34-41376)

IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

A proposed rule change filed by the American Stock Exchange decreasing options transaction fees (SR-Amex-99-12) has become effective under Section 19(b)(3)(A) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of May 10. (Rel. 34-41370)

A proposed rule change (SR-CBOE-99-16) filed by the Chicago Board Options Exchange relating to the listing and trading of generic narrow-based index options under Rule 19b-4(e) has become effective

under Section 19(b)(3)(A) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of March 10. (Rel. 34-41374)

EXEMPTION FROM CLEARING AGENCY REGISTRATION

The Commission has approved an application filed by Thomson Financial Technology Services, Inc. (TFTS) for exemption from clearing agency registration (File No. 600-31). Under the exemption, TFTS will be permitted to provide matching services for securities trades. (Rel. 34-41377)
