ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

IN THE MATTER OF FU-SUNG PETER WU

Administrative Law Judge Lillian A. McEwen issued an Initial Decision today in the above referenced matter. The Division of Enforcement alleged that Respondent Wu, a registered representative associated with a broker-dealer registered with the Commission, willfully violated Section 17(a) of the Securities Act, Section 10(b) of the Exchange Act and Rule 10b-5 thereunder, by making material misrepresentations and omitting to state material facts in connection with the secondary market trading of Netscape Communications Corporation stock. Specifically, the Division alleged that Mr. Wu misled his customers as to the price at which they could purchase Netscape stock in aftermarket trading; failed to disclose risks associated with investing in the stock; made unauthorized transactions in customer accounts; and altered customer account documents. Judge McEwen concluded that Respondent Wu willfully violated Sections 17(a)(2) and 17(a)(3) of the Securities Act in that he negligently made misrepresentations and omissions of material facts, and that he negligently engaged in transactions, practices, or courses of business which operated or would operate as a fraud or deceit upon purchasers of securities. Judge McEwen further concluded, however, that Mr. Wu did not act with scienter, and therefore did not willfully violate Section 17(a)(1) of the Securities Act, nor did he willfully violate Section 10(b) of the Exchange Act and Rule 10b-5 thereunder. Accordingly, the Decision orders Mr. Wu to cease and desist from committing or causing any violations or future violations of Sections 17(a)(2) and 17(a)(3) of the Securities Act. (Initial Decision No. 144; File No. 3-9024)

ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDING SETTLED AGAINST FORMER PORTFOLIO MANAGER IN CONNECTION WITH CS FIRST BOSTON OFFSHORE CASH RESERVE FUND

On July 13, the Commission entered a settled order against Keith E. Walsh, formerly a portfolio manager for CS First Boston Investment Management Corporation (CSFBIMC) and the CS First Boston Offshore Cash Reserve Fund (Fund). The Order finds that in late 1993 and early 1994 Walsh invested the majority of the Fund's assets in structured rate notes, which was inconsistent with the Fund's offering circular and investment objectives. The Order also finds

that Walsh created marketing charts and graphs which were misleading with respect to the content and composition of the Fund and that Walsh mispriced securities in the portfolio resulting in an overstated net asset value. The Order finds that Walsh willfully violated the antifraud provisions of the Securities Act of 1933 (Securities Act) and the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (Exchange Act) and willfully aided and abetted and caused violations of the antifraud provisions of the Investment Advisers Act. Without admitting or denying the findings in the Order, Walsh has consented: (i) to cease and desist from committing or causing any future violations of Section 17(a) of the Securities Act, Section 10(b) of the Exchange Act and Rule 10b-5 thereunder and Section 206(1) and 206(2) of the Advisers Act; and (ii) to be barred from association with any broker, dealer, investment adviser or investment company with a right to reapply after three years.

The Commission previously instituted contested administrative proceedings against Sean P. Brennan and Walsh on September 23, 1998 (Exchange Act Release No. 40466). The Commission settled with Sean P. Brennan, formerly Vice President of Sales and Marketing for CSFBIMC, pursuant to an order entered on December 23, 1998. In two related settled administrative proceedings; In the Matter of CS First Boston Investment Management Corporation, Admin. Proc. File No. 3- 9715 (September 23, 1998) and In the Matter of Nicholas C. Bogard, Admin. Proc. File No. 3-9717 (September 23, 1998), the Commission sanctioned CSFBIMC and supervisor, Nicholas Bogard. CIVIL ACTION AGAINST ARTHUR SHOEMAKER

The Commission announced today that it sued a former senior engineer of Galileo Corporation for insider trading in advance of a February 12, 1997 announcement that Galileo was losing its largest customer, Xerox Corporation. Galileo Corporation of Sturbridge, Massachusetts manufactures fiberoptic and electro-optic products. The announcement had a devastating effect on Galileo's stock price, causing it to decline by 63%.

In its complaint, filed today in federal court in Massachusetts, the Commission alleges that Arthur H. Shoemaker, formerly of Southbridge, Massachusetts and at the time the director of development of Galileo's medical products group, sold 7,700 shares of Galileo on February 12, 1997 shortly after learning the nonpublic information that Xerox had terminated Galileo as a supplier. After the close of the market that day, Galileo announced the loss of the Xerox business causing the price of Galileo's stock to decrease from its February 12, 1997 closing price of \$18.625 to a February 13, 1997 closing price of \$6.875. At the time Xerox's purchases of dicorotrons, Galileo's highest volume office product, accounted for 48% of Galileo's total sales revenues and a substantial amount of its profits. By trading in advance of the announcement, Shoemaker illegally avoided a loss of approximately \$87,827 on his sales.

The complaint alleges that Shoemaker, by trading on the basis of material nonpublic information, violated Section 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1933 and Section 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rule 10b-5 thereunder. The complaint seeks entry of a Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction enjoining Shoemaker from future securities laws violations, requiring him to disgorge an amount equal to his losses avoided as a result of his illegal trading, prejudgment interest, and imposing civil penalties of up to three times the amount of the losses he avoided. COMPLAINT FILED AGAINST ROBERT COHEN, VICTOR CARON AND JAMES YATES JR.

On July 22, the Commission filed a complaint in United States District Court for the Southern District of New York against defendants Robert E. Cohen (Cohen), Victor M. Caron (Caron), and James B. Yates, Jr. (Yates, Jr.). The Commission alleges that the defendants engaged in a scheme to sell unregistered microcap stock into the United States market through a series of intermediate sham sales to purported residents of Liberia. In furtherance of their scheme, the Commission alleges that Cohen, Caron, and Yates Jr. used two nominees to orchestrate the fraudulent sale of 2.5 million shares of stock in a now defunct New York computer retailer named Blue Chip Computerware, Inc. The Commission charges that from 1993 through 1995 Cohen, Caron, and Yates Jr. received more than \$1.7 million in illegal profits from their scheme.

The Commission's complaint seeks permanent injunctive relief, disgorgement plus prejudgment interest, and civil penalties against all three defendants and an order commanding Cohen to comply with a prior Commission order barring him from associating with any broker or dealer. INVESTMENT ADVISERS ACT RELEASES

GOLDMAN SACHS ASSET MANAGEMENT

An order has been issued on an application filed by Goldman Sachs Asset Management (GSAM) and the Hirtle Callaghan Trust (Trust) under Section 206A of the Investment Advisers Act granting an exemption from Section 205 of the Act and Advisers Act Rule 205-1. The order permits GSAM to charge a performance fee based on the performance of that portion of a Trust portfolio managed by GSAM (GSAM Account). The order further permits applicants to compute the performance-related portion of the fee using changes in the GSAM Account's gross asset value rather than net asset value. (Rel. IA-1809 - July 21)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

IDS BOND FUND, INC., ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until August 16, 1999, to request a hearing on an application filed by IDS Bond Fund, Inc., et al. for an order under Section 17(d) of the Investment Company Act and Rule 17d-1 to permit certain registered management investment companies to deposit uninvested cash balances in joint accounts investing in short-term investments. NUVEEN UNIT TRUSTS, ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until August 16, 1999, to request a hearing on an application filed by Nuveen Unit Trusts (Trust) and John Nuveen & Co., Inc. (Sponsor). Applicants request an order (a) under Section 12(d)(1)(J) of the Investment Company Act that would permit each series of the Trust and any future trusts sponsored by the Sponsor to offer its shares to the public with a sales load that exceeds the 1.5% limit of Section 12(d)(1)(F)(ii); and (b) under Sections 6(c) and 17(b) of the Act for an exemption from Section 17(a) of the Act to permit the Trust to invest in affiliated registered investment companies within the limits of Section 12(d)(1)(F) of the Act. DEUTSCHE BANK SECURITIES INC.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until August 16, 1999, to request a hearing on an application filed by Deutsche Bank Securities Inc. (Deutsche Securities) for an order under (i) Section 12(d)(1)(J) of the Investment Company Act exempting Mandatory Exchangeable Trust Securities trusts for which Deutsche Securities will serve as a principal underwriter (Trusts) from Section 12(d)(1) of the Act, (ii) Section 6(c) of the Act exempting the Trusts from Section 14(a) of the Act, and (iii) Section 17(b) of the Act exempting Deutsche Bank and the Trusts from Section 17(a) of the Act. The requested order would (i) permit other registered investment companies, and companies excepted from the definition of investment company under Section 3(c)(1) or (c)(7) of the Act, to own a greater percentage of the total outstanding voting stock (Securities) of each Trust than that permitted by Section 12(d)(1), (ii) exempt the Trusts from the initial net worth requirements of Section 14(a), and (iii) permit the Trusts to purchase U.S. government securities from Deutsche Bank at the time of a Trust's initial issuance of Securities. SMITH BREEDEN TRUST, ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until August 16, 1999, to request a hearing on an application filed by Smith Breeden

Trust, et al. for an order exempting applicants from Section 12(d)(1)(G)(i)(II) of the Investment Company Act. The order would permit funds of funds relying on Section 12(d)(1)(G) of the Act to invest in securities and other instruments. (Rel. IC-23918 -July 21)
