ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

ROBERT J. MELEDANDRI, JR. SANCTIONED

On February 29, 2000, the Commission issued an Order Making Findings and Imposing Remedial Sanctions and Issuing a Cease and Desist Order against Robert J. Meledandri, Jr. (Meledandri). The Order Bars Meledandri from association with any broker or dealer, with a right to reapply for association after three years, and orders him to cease and desist from committing or causing any violations and any future violations of Section 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1933; Section 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rule 10b-5 thereunder. The Order also requires Meledandri to pay disgorgement in the amount of \$4,466.17, together with prejudgment interest in the amount of \$651, and a civil penalty in the amount of \$10,000. Meledandri consented to the entry of the Order without admitting or denying the findings therein.

The Order finds that from November 1996 through February 18, 1997, Meledandri, while employed by the Allentown, Pennsylvania Branch Office of Prudential Securities, Inc., executed unauthorized transactions in customer accounts and fraudulently solicited funds from a customer. The Order finds that Meledandri executed approximately 55 transactions in nine customer accounts without the customers' knowledge or consent. The Order finds that, as a result of these unauthorized transactions, Meledandri's customers suffered losses in excess of \$500,000, and that Meledandri earned commissions of \$4,466.17. The Order also finds that Meledandri solicited \$20,000 from a customer to purchase a so-called tax-free bond, purportedly being issued by a company called Cetronia Holdings (Cetronia). The Order finds that the bond did not exist, and that Meledandri failed to disclose to the customer, among other things, that Cetronia was owned by Meledandri and his wife. The Order further finds that Meledandri misappropriated the \$20,000 and used it for his personal expenses. The Order also finds that in March 1997, Meledandri tendered a check in the amount of \$20,077 to the customer. (Rels 33-7805; 34-42471; File No 3-9723)

ROBERT SPIEGEL SETTLES INSIDER TRADING CASE

On February 29, 2000, the Commission filed a complaint in the United States District Court for the Southern District of New York against Robert Spiegel (Robert Spiegel) of Norwood,

New Jersey The complaint alleges that Spiegel engaged in insider trading in advance of public announcements concerning the securities of four publicly traded companies. Spiegel also recommended three of the securities to a family member. According to the complaint, Spiegel received tips containing material, nonpublic information concerning the securities of these four companies from his brother, Jeffrey Spiegel. Jeffrey Spiegel had received the tips from Tina Eichenholz, his former girlfriend. She had received the tips from Jeffrey Streich, who had received them from Marisa Baridis, a former compliance employee at two Wall Street investment firms, who had access to confidential information concerning the firms' clients. The complaint alleges that Spiegel, trading in securities of the four companies, realized illegal profits of \$21,187.50. The family member Spiegel tipped traded the three securities that Spiegel had recommended. Spiegel and/or the family member he tipped directed trading in all four securities in accounts of others. The family member Spiegel tipped or other beneficiaries realized profits of \$53,574.50.

Spiegel consented, without admitting or denying the allegations in the complaint, to the entry of a Final Judgment enjoining him from future violations of Sections 10(b) and 14(e) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rule 10b-5 and 14e-3 thereunder, and requiring him to disgorge illegal trading profits of \$74,762, plus prejudgment interest and a civil penalty of \$74,762.

COMMISSION OBTAINS TRO AND PRELIMINARY INJUNCTION AGAINST CHRISTOPHER LOWRY AND FOUNTAINHEAD RETIREMENT PLAN SERVICES, INC. d/b/a 401(k) UNIVERSITY

The Commission announced that on February 15, 2000, the United States District Court for the District of Minnesota issued a Temporary Restraining Order (TRO), temporarily barring Defendants Christopher A. Lowry (Lowry) and Fountainhead Retirement Plan Services, Inc. d/b/a 401(k) University (401(k) University) from violations of the antifraud provisions of the federal securities laws. The TRO also froze the assets of Lowry and 401(k) University. On February 23, 2000, Lowry and 401(k) University agreed to the entry of a preliminary injunction, which continued the relief provided in the TRO.

In its complaint, the Commission alleges that Lowry and 401(k) University raised approximately \$488,000 from 14 individuals who purchased stock of 401(k) University. All the investors are located in the Minneapolis/St. Paul area of Minnesota. The Commission alleges that Lowry and 401(k) University misrepresented the use of investor proceeds and that Lowry misappropriated at least \$156,500 of investor funds which he used to buy his personal residence. SEC CHARGES PRISON INMATE WITH IPO SCAM THAT DEFRAUDED OVER 190 INVESTORS OF \$8.7 MILLION

Yesterday, in federal district court in Manhattan, the Securities and Exchange Commission charged Ira A. Monas—who is currently incarcerated in an upstate New York prison for grand larceny—with defrauding over 190 investors of approximately \$8.7 million in a scam involving several highly publicized initial public offerings (“IPOs”) of securities. The Commission also charged in the scam two entities controlled by Monas—Milan Capital Group, Inc. and the broker-dealer Investment Offices (which operated under the name AC Financial, Inc.)—along with Michael Irwin Lamhut, the operations manager of Milan Capital, and Jason M. Cope, the branch manager of AC Financial’s Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania office.

The amended complaint alleges that: In the fall of 1999, Monas, along with the other defendants, offered and purportedly sold to investors shares in four “hot” IPOs, meaning that the securities offerings were oversubscribed and difficult to purchase. The defendants collected \$8.7 million from approximately 190 investors, who were told that the defendants had access to the market for these highly-publicized IPOs and could purchase shares in the IPOs at the initial offering prices. These representations were false. The defendants neither had access to the exclusive IPO market nor purchased IPO shares for the investors. Instead, the defendants stole the investors’ money and, to create the illusion of legitimate stock purchases, gave the investors phony trade confirmations and account statements. The defendants also returned relatively small sums of money to some victims who were defrauded in the early stages of the scheme, and falsely represented these monies as repayment of principal and profits on the sham IPO investments.

Yesterday’s action expands the case initially brought by the Commission, on January 7, 2000, which alleged that Milan Capital had violated broker-dealer registration provisions by offering for sale and purportedly selling IPO securities, while failing to be registered as a broker-dealer with the Commission. In that action, among other things, Judge Denise Cote of the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of New York: (1) froze all funds and other assets held in Milan Capital’s name, including \$3.7 million held in a bank account; and (2) preliminarily enjoined Milan Capital from acting as an unregistered broker-dealer. On January 21, 2000, the Court appointed a receiver for Milan Capital. The receiver is charged with, among other things, (1) identifying and securing Milan Capital’s assets and property, (2) ascertaining the disposition of investors’ funds, and (3) ensuring the fair treatment of all investors who dealt with Milan Capital.

The complaint charges that the defendants, through their respective roles in the IPO scam, violated the antifraud provisions of the federal securities laws, Section 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1933 and Section 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rule 10b-5 thereunder. The complaint also charges Milan Capital with violating, and the other defendants with aiding and abetting Milan Capital’s violations of, the broker-dealer registration provisions, Section 15(a) of the Exchange Act. As to the defendants, the SEC seeks permanent prohibitory injunctions, verified accountings of the defendants’ receipt

and disbursement of investors' funds, disgorgement of the defendants' ill-gotten gains plus prejudgment interest, and civil money penalties. As to six named relief defendants, the SEC seeks verified accountings of the relief defendants' receipt and disbursement of investors' funds, the return of the investors' funds that they received, and prejudgment interest thereon.

(ESC Funds) and SunTrust Banks, Inc for an order under Section 17(b) of the Investment Company Act exempting applicants from Section 17(a) of the Act The order would permit certain series of STI Funds to acquire all of the assets and certain stated liabilities of the series of ESC Strategic Funds, Inc Because of certain affiliations, applicants may not rely on Rule 17a-8 under the Act (Rel IC-24320 – February 28)

ASA LIMITED

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until March 24 to request a hearing on an application filed by ASA Limited (ASA) The requested order would permit ASA, a South African closed-end management investment company registered under Section 7(d) of the Investment Company Act , to maintain its assets with a central securities depository in South Africa (Rel IC-24321; International Series Rel. 1216 – February 29)

HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

INDIANA MICHIGAN POWER COMPANY

A supplemental order has been issued authorizing a proposal by Indiana Michigan Power Company (I&M), an electric utility subsidiary of American Electric Power Company, Inc., a registered holding company. I&M is proposing to effect the refunding of up to \$50 million of pollution control revenue bonds issued in connection with the financing of pollution control facilities, prior to June 30, 2000.
