ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

TUSCHNER & COMPANY, INC. BROKER-DEALER REGISTRATION REVOKED

On March 21, the Commission entered an Order Instituting Public Administrative Proceedings Pursuant to Section 15(b) and 19(h) of the Securities and Exchange Act of 1934, Making Findings and Imposing Remedial Sanctions (Order) against Tuschner & Company, Inc. (Tuschner & Company), based on the entry of a permanent injunction against Tuschner & Company in the United States District Court, District of Minnesota. Tuschner & Company consented to entry of the order without admitting or denying the Commission's findings, except as to jurisdiction and to the entry of the permanent injunction, which were admitted.

The Order finds that Tuschner & Company was a registered with the Commission as a broker or dealer from 1994 through 1999. On March 9, 2000, in the case of SEC v. Nicholas A. Zahareas, et. al., (Case No. 97-2859), the Honorable David Doty, United States District Judge for the District of Minnesota, entered an Order of Permanent Injunction against Tuschner & Company, pursuant to its consent and without Tuschner & Company's admitting or denying the allegations in the Commission's Complaint, enjoining Tuschner & Company from violating Section 15(b)(6)(B)(ii) of the Exchange Act. The Complaint alleged that Tuschner & Company associated with Nicholas A. Zahareas (Zahareas) from June 1996 to December 1997, without the consent of the Commission, when it knew, or reasonably should have known, that Zahareas was a person subject to an order barring him from association with a broker or dealer. The complaint further alleged that, as a result of the wrongful association, Tuschner & Company earned approximately \$210,000.00 in gross commissions from sales to customers obtained through its association with Zahareas. PITTS AND HANSON ORDERED TO CEASE AND DESIST

The Commission announced that Janet Hanson and Jill Pitts (Respondents), former employees of ABS Industries, Inc (ABS), were ordered to cease and desist in administrative proceedings based on their causing ABS and four other former employees to

violate certain provisions of the federal securities laws. The Order finds that ABS, its Chief Executive Officer (Chief Executive Officer), its Chief Accounting Officer, the Corporate Controller for both of ABS' subsidiaries, and the General Manager of one of ABS' subsidiaries engaged in a scheme to defraud the market by prematurely recording sales and accounts receivable from purported "bill and hold" transactions in ABS' 1994 Form 10-K and 1995 Forms 10-Q in violation of Sections 10(b), 13(a), 13(b)(2)(A), 13(b)(2)(B), and 13(b)(5) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rules 10b-5, 12b-20, 13a-1, 13a-13, 13b2-1 and 13b2-2 thereunder. The Order finds that Respondents caused the violations of Sections 13(a), 13(b)(2)(A), 13(b)(2)(B) and 13(b)(5) and Rules 12b-20, 13a-1, 13a-13, and 13b2-1 and orders them to cease and desist from committing or causing any violation and any future violation of these provisions. Respondents consented to the entry of the Order, without admitting or denying the Commission's findings, except as to jurisdiction and their previous employment with ABS, which were admitted (Rel 34-42569, AAE Rel 1240, File No 3-10166)

INITIAL DECISION FINAL WITH RESPECT TO BRIAN SCHMIDT, DARLAN GORDON, WILLIAM AVENT, AND JOHN DILWORTH II

The Commission has announced that the law judge's initial decision in this matter is final with respect to Brian A. Schmidt, Darlan E. Gordon, William Avent, and John Aristotle Dilworth II. The law judge found that Schmidt, Gordon, Avent, and Dilworth willfully violated Securities Act Section 17(a) in connection with a purported Treasury Bill leasing scheme.

The law judge ordered Schmidt, Gordon, Avent, and Dilworth to cease and desist from committing any violations or future violations of Section 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1933. He further required Gordon, Avent, and Dilworth to disgorge, jointly and severally, \$300,000, plus prejudgment interest. Schmidt was barred from association with any broker or dealer and ordered to pay a civil penalty of \$100,000. (Rel 34-42570, File No 3-9402)

COMMISSION SEEKS EMERGENCY RELIEF IN CONNECTION WITH MANIPULATION SCHEME OVER THE INTERNET

The Commission announced that on March 23 in the United States District Court for the Central District of California, it filed a complaint and sought a temporary restraining order against eConnect and its president, Thomas S. Hughes (Hughes). The complaint and emergency application seek to temporarily and permanently restrain eConnect and Hughes from violating the antifraud provisions of the federal securities laws.

The complaint alleges that, since February 28, 2000, eConnect issued press releases that made false and misleading claims that: (1) eConnect and its joint venture partner had a unique licensing arrangement with PalmPilot; and (2) a subsidiary of eConnect had a strategic alliance with a brokerage firm concerning a system that would permit cash transactions over the Internet. The complaint further alleges that the fraudulent press releases misrepresented eConnect's potential business opportunities, thereby causing a

dramatic rise in the price of eConnect stock from \$1.39 on February 28 to a high of \$21.88 on March 9, 2000, on heavy trading volume. The Commission suspended trading in eConnect's stock on March 13. The complaint alleges that despite the trading suspension and the Commission's related investigation, eConnect and Hughes continued to issue false and misleading statements concerning eConnect's business opportunities.

The Commission seeks permanently to enjoin Defendants from further violations of Section 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rule 10b-5 thereunder. The Commission also seeks civil penalties against the defendants. [SEC v. eConnect and Thomas S. Hughes, Civil Action No. CV 00-02959 AHM, C.D. Cal.] (LR-16481)

SEC CHARGES GIDVANI IN INSIDER TRADING CASE

On March 23, the Commission filed a complaint in the United States District Court for the Southern District of Texas against Parvin Gidvani (Gidvani) of Houston, Texas. The complaint alleges that Gidvani engaged in insider trading in advance of a public announcement concerning the securities of Owen Healthcare, Inc (Owen). According to the complaint, Gidvani, had access to material, nonpublic information concerning the acquisition of Owen by Cardinal Healthcare, Inc. The complaint alleges that Gidvani, while in possession of that information, traded in securities of Owen and realized illegal profits of \$23,500. It further alleges that Gidvani recommended Owen to two of his friends. The two friends also traded in securities of Owen and realized profits of \$41,250 and \$39,250, respectively. PUBLISHERS OF TOUT SHEET AGREE TO PAY \$325,000 IN PENALTIES AND DISGORGEMENT

The Commission announced the settlement with Michael St. John Hall, Kathleen Bradford Hall, and the Arrowhead Financial Group, Inc. (Arrowhead), publishers of the *Arrowhead Financial Growth Newsletter* (Arrowhead Newsletter) from June 1996 to July 1997. The case involved the touting of the securities of small-cap companies in return for undisclosed compensation. Without admitting or denying the allegations of the complaint the defendants agreed to the entry of a permanent injunction enjoining them from future violations of the anti-touting and antifraud provisions of the federal securities laws. The defendants further agreed to pay a civil penalty of \$305,000, to disgorge \$15,000 in subscription fees, and to pay \$5,000 in prejudgment interest.

The complaint, filed in the United States District Court for the District of Colorado, alleges that the defendants mailed the Arrowhead Newsletter to as many as 60,000 investors a month. The newsletter touted the stocks of a total of 50 small-cap issuers who paid consideration in stock and cash for this service. Each of the 11 newsletters failed to disclose, or disclosed inadequately, that the Halls had received consideration in exchange for promoting the featured securities, under Section 17(b) of the Securities Act of 1933. Further, the complaint alleges that the Halls violated Section 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 by representing the Arrowhead Newsletter as an objective research

report drafted by qualified analysts, when, in fact, the newsletter was simply a paid tout sheet.

The Commission approved a proposed rule change and issued notice of filing and granted accelerated approval to Amendment Nos. 1 and 2 to a proposed rule change submitted by the Chicago Board Options Exchange (SR-CBOE-99-21) relating to the Exchange's Firm Quote Rule (Rel 34-42558)

The Commission approved a proposed rule change submitted by the Philadelphia Stock Exchange (SR-Phlx-99-46) relating to registration of trading floor personnel. Publication of the order in the Federal Register is expected during the week of March 27 (Rel 34-42564)

IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES
