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## ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

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### **ARNOLD ZOUSMER CONSENTS TO THE ENTRY OF AN ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER BASED UPON HIS CONSENT TO THE ENTRY OF A FINAL JUDGMENT ENJOINING HIM FROM VIOLATING THE REGISTRATION PROVISIONS OF THE SECURITIES ACT**

On May 23, the Commission instituted and settled administrative proceedings, pursuant to Sections 15(b)(6) and 19(h) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (Exchange Act), against Arnold Zousmer.

The Commission found that Zousmer, who was a registered representative during the relevant time, consented to the entry of a final judgment that permanently enjoined him from violating Section 5 of the Securities Act of 1933, directed him to pay, jointly and severally with three other defendants in that action, disgorgement and prejudgment interest in the amount of \$963,000, and directed him to pay a civil penalty of \$15,000. The action, filed in the United States District Court for the Middle District of Florida, is styled SEC v. Corporate Relations Group, Inc., et al., C.A. No. 99-1222-CV-22-A (filed Sept. 27, 1999).

Without admitting or denying the Commission's findings, Zousmer consented to the entry of an order which suspends him from association with any broker or dealer for a period of three months, and which requires him, within 30 days after the end of the suspension, to provide an affidavit to the Commission that he has complied fully with the suspension. ### **C. WILLIAM COX, FORMER PRESIDENT OF PUBLICLY TRADED COMPANY, ENJOINED**

On May 23, the Commission filed a civil fraud suit against C William Cox (Cox), the former president and chief executive officer of Intile Designs, Inc (Intile), for causing Intile, a publicly traded company, to misstate its accrued expenses and liabilities by as much

as 55% and its net income by as much as 45% over a five year period. Intile was an importer and distributor of brick, stone and ceramic building products, and its common stock was quoted on the OTC Bulletin Board under the symbol "IDSN" during the relevant period

The complaint alleges that Cox single-handedly carried out a scheme to underpay Intile's local inventory property taxes, by underreporting the value of its inventory by 85% - 90% in local tax filings. Consequently, Intile underpaid its property taxes by approximately \$1,069,000 over the five-year period. As a result, Intile understated its accrued expenses and liabilities by as much as 55%, and overstated its net income by as much as 46%, in periodic reports filed with the Commission during fiscal years 1994 through 1997. Finally, the complaint also alleges that Cox's actions caused Intile to violate record-keeping provisions of the federal securities laws.

Simultaneously with the filing of its action, the Commission accepted Cox's offer of settlement in which he agreed, without admitting or denying the allegations in the Commission's complaint, to an injunction prohibiting him from future violations of the antifraud, reporting, and books and records provisions of the federal securities laws and from serving as an officer or director of any public company. A financial civil penalty was not assessed, based on Cox's demonstrated financial inability to pay.

On May 23, the Commission also instituted cease and desist proceedings against Intile and simultaneously accepted Intile's offer of settlement in which it agreed, without admitting or denying the findings in the Commission's order, to cease and desist from future violations of the federal securities laws. 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## **INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES**

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### **SSgA FUNDS AND STATE STREET BANK AND TRUST COMPANY**

An order has been issued on an application filed by SSgA Funds and State Street Bank and Trust Company under Section 12(d)(1)(J) of the Investment Company Act, under Sections 6(c) and 17(b) of the Act, and Rule 17d-1 under the Act to permit certain joint transactions. The order permits certain registered open-end management investment companies to invest uninvested cash and cash collateral in affiliated money market funds and/or short-term bond funds. (Rel. 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### IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

A proposed rule change filed by the Chicago Board Options Exchange to rescind certain customer equity options fees (SR-CBOE-00-19) has become immediately effective under Section 19(b)(3)(A)(ii) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of May 22. (Rel. 34-42798)

A proposed rule change filed by the Philadelphia Stock Exchange to adopt a new transaction fee of \$0.20 per trade for specialists trading on the Philadelphia Stock Exchange Automated Communication System (SR-Phlx-00-42) has become immediately effective under Section 19(b)(3)(A)(ii) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of May 22. (Rel. 34-42802)
