### TEXAS MAN INDICTED IN BOSTON

The Honorable William F. Weld, U.S. Attorney for the District of Massachusetts and the Boston Regional Office announced that on March 18 Reginald Bernard Chisholm, also known as Doctor Reginald Bernard, was indicted by a U.S. grand jury in Boston, Massachusetts. Chisholm, who now resides in San Antonio, Texas was charged in 18 counts with securities violations, mail and wire fraud. The indictment alleges that he raised over \$1,200,000 from investors in New England and throughout the U.S.

The indictment follows a Commission action filed on June 7, 1979 (SEC v. Reginald Bernard Chisholm, et al., D.C. Ma. 79-1114-2) which resulted in the entry on June 11, 1979 of permanent injunctions against Chisholm and three of his corporations from further violations of the registration and antifraud provisions of the securities laws.

The indictment, like the Commission's complaint, alleged that the defendants sold securities in the form of investment contracts for the development and management of various real estate and other commercial ventures. (SEC v. Reginald Bernard Chisholm, et al., D.C. MA 79-1114-2). (LR-9928)

### NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

Rule changes filed by the Midwest Clearing Corporation (MCC) and the Midwest Securities Trust Company (MSTC), pursuant to Rule 19b-4, have been filed in accordance with the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. The proposed rule changes (SR-MCC-82-15 and SR-MSTC-82-19) deletes in its entirety MCC's and MSTC's existing audit rule, but inserts a rule change which will provide that MCC's and MSTC's annual financial statements will be audited in accordance with generally accepted auditing standards by a firm of independent public accountants selected by their Boards of Directors. Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
