ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved, on an accelerated basis, a proposed rule change filed by The Boston Stock Exchange, Inc. (SR-BSE-85-1) to amend several of its rules relating to arbitration. Among other changes, the proposed amendments would affect the six-year time limitation on arbitrations, the pleadings of responding parties, the procedures for amendment of pleadings, fee schedules, and the jurisdictional limit for small claim proceedings. COMMENTS REQUESTED ON PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Commission is soliciting comments on proposed rule changes filed by the Municipal Securities Rulemaking Board and the National Securities Clearing Corporation: (SR-MSRB-85-9) to amend MSRB Rules G-12 and G-15 to require confirmation disclosure of certain transactions in securities sold at an original issue discount from par.
