ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

PROCEEDINGS INSTITUTED AND SANCTIONS IMPOSED AGAINST AMERICAN COMMERCIAL SECURITIES CORPORATION, OTHERS

The Commission simultaneously instituted administrative proceedings and imposed sanctions against American Commercial Securities Corporation, a Greensboro, North Carolina broker-dealer, its president, Roger D. Berliner, and Jack P. LaTorre, Sr. and Jack P. LaTorre, Jr., formerly with the firm's Charlotte office. The respondents consented to the findings and sanctions without admitting or denying the allegations.

The Commission found that respondents had committed or aided and abetted several types of violations including the sale of securities when no registration statement was on file on in effect, fraud in the sale of securities by misrepresenting or omitting important facts; a failure to keep a variety of records related to the business of a broker; and a failure to comply with rules designed to ensure financial solvency for brokers.

The Commission's sanctions included a suspension of American's registration for one year; a suspension of Berliner for four months and a bar from association in a supervisory capacity and from owning greater than 33% of any regulated entity; and 30-day suspensions of LaTorre, Sr. and LaTorre, Jr., along with a nine-month suspension of LaTorre, Sr. from supervisory responsibilities. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

MONARCH LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY

An order has been issued exempting Monarch Life Insurance Company and its Variable Account B from the provisions of Sections 12(d)(1), 26(a)(2), and 27(c)(2) of the Investment Company Act permitting the Account to offer single premium variable life insurance contracts funded by a unit investment trust comprised of stripped U.S. Treasury securities. The order also approves the terms of certain exchange offers involving these contracts. (Rel. IC-14460 - April 9)

SALOMON BROTHERS UNIT INVESTMENT TRUST

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until April 30 to request a hearing on an application filed by Salomon Brothers Unit Investment Trust, Insured Tax-Exempt Series One and subsequent and similar series of trusts, and its sponsor, Salomon Brothers Inc. for an order exempting them from the provisions of Sections 11(c), 17(a), 17(d) and 26(a)(2)(C) of the Investment Company Act and Rule 17d-1 to engage in certain transactions described in the application. MERRILL LYNCH CORPORATE DIVIDEND FUND, INC.

An order has been issued exempting Applicants from the provisions of Sections 17(f) and 18(f)(1) of the Investment Company Act to permit them to trade interest rate futures contracts, stock index futures contracts, municipal bond index futures contracts and related options: Merrill Lynch Corporate Dividend Fund, Inc., Merrill Lynch Corporate Bond Fund, Inc., Merrill Lynch Municipal Bond Fund, Inc., Merrill Lynch Federal Securities Trust, Merrill Lynch Asset Management, Inc. (MLAM) and Fund Asset Management, Inc. (FAMI), and any other registered investment companies now advised, or which in the future may be advised, by MLAM or FAMI, and which may engage in the trading activities described in the application. (Rel. IC-14462 - April 9)

HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

SYSTEM FUELS, INC.

An order has been issued authorizing a proposal by System Fuels, Inc. (SFI), Louisiana Power & Light Company, Arkansas Power & Light Company, and Middle South Energy, Inc., subsidiaries of Middle South Utilities, Inc., wherein SFI will enter into a revolving credit agreement for system nuclear fuel financing with Prudential Interfunding Corp. for up to \$50 million of borrowings for two years, which may be extended for additional one-year periods. (Rel. 35-23659 - April 9)

VERMONT YANKEE NUCLEAR POWER CORPORATION

An order has been issued authorizing Vermont Yankee Nuclear Power Corporation, subsidiary of both New York England Electric System and Northeast Utilities, to issue and sell up to \$16 million of short-term notes to banks through February 28, 1986. (Rel. 35-23660 - April 9)

SOUTHEASTERN MICHIGAN GAS ENTERPRISES, INC.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until May 3 to request a hearing on a proposal by Southeastern Michigan Gas Enterprises, Inc., an exempt holding company, to acquire Battle Creek Gas Company. (Rel. 35-23661 - April 9)

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed by the Boston Stock Exchange, Inc. (SR-BSE-84-8) which would implement the second phase of a BSE-Montreal Exchange linkage to expand the list of securities eligible to trade through the linkage to include approximately 200 United States - listed securities available for trading through the Intermarket Trading System. (Rel. 34-21925)

NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Chicago Board Options Exchange, Incorporated filed a proposed rule change under Rule 19b-4 (SR-CBOE-85-10) to provide that stop and stop-limit orders in the S&P 100 Index become effective when either a transaction has occurred at the stop price or the market quotation on the same side of the market equals the price on the order. Publication of the proposal is expected to be made in the Federal Register during the week of April 8. (Rel. 34-21926)
