CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

PERMANENT RECEIVER APPOINTED FOR FIRST OIL AND GAS COMPANY

The Los Angeles Regional Office announced that on May 13 Judge Irving Hill, District Court for the Central District of California, entered an Order Appointing Permanent Receiver to marshal, preserve and take control of the assets of First Oil and Gas Company, and entered instructions authorizing and directing him to take custody and possession of John Gust Westine's one-half interest in an office building located in Santa Monica, California.

The February 27 complaint alleges that: since at least March 1984 First Oil, Westine and others offered and sold \$2.8 million of securities in the form of limited partnership interests and investment contracts in producing oil and gas wells or in oil and gas drilling sites on properties located in Coalinga, California; in these offers and sales, First Oil and Westine misrepresented, among other things, the existence of drilling operations, the amount of money earned from drilling operations, the use of investors' funds, and the sources of funds used to pay returns to investors in the securities; and First Oil violated the broker registration provisions of the securities laws in the offer and sale of limited partnership interests. The Court issued a Temporary Restraining Order on February 28 and an Order of Preliminary Injunction on March 11. (SEC v. First Oil and Gas Company and John G. Westine, CDCA, Civil Action No. 85-1370 IH). (LR-10767)

PETROWEST, INCORPORATED, OTHERS PERMANENTLY ENJOINED

The Fort Worth Regional Office announced that on May 24 Judge A. Joe Fish, U.S. District Court for the Northern District of Texas, Dallas Division, issued an Order of Permanent Injunction against PetroWest, Incorporated, Explorer Energy Inc., Vision Energy Corporation, Enersource, Inc., American Investment Management, Inc., and Consolidated Oil Field Services and Equipment, Inc., all located in Dallas, Texas. The Order was entered following a motion for summary judgment, which was granted after the above-named defendants failed to file a response to the motion. The Order permanently enjoins each of the above-named defendants from further violations of the registration and antifraud provisions of the Securities Act of 1933 and the antifraud provisions of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. The other defendants, Merle L. Matlock and Charles E. Forrer, had previously consented to Orders of Permanent Injunction against them without admitting or denying the allegations of the Commission's complaint. In a related case, Matlock was convicted of fraud in the sale of securities on December 8, 1983 [State of Texas v. Merle Lee Matlock, F82-99048-PS, Dallas County, Texas]. Matlock was sentenced to five years incarceration and \$5,000 in fines, and is presently appealing that conviction. (SEC v. PetroWest, Incorporated, et al., USDC/ ND/TEX/Dallas Div., CA File No. 3-82-0160G). (LR-10770)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

GREAT-WEST LIFE AND ANNUITY INSURANCE COMPANY

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until June 26 to request a hearing on an application by Great-West Life and Annuity Insurance Company, et al., for an order granting exemptions from certain provisions of Sections 9(a), 13(a), 15(a), 26(a) and 27(c)(2) of the Investment Company Act in the offering of single premium variable life insurance policies. HARTFORD GOVERNMENT SECURITIES FUND, INC.

An order has been issued declaring that Hartford Government Securities Fund, Inc. has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-14554 - June 4)

DAILY INCOME FUND, INC.

An order has been issued permitting Daily Income Fund, Inc. and Reich & Tang, Inc. to share certain legal fees and expenses. (Rel. IC-14555 - June 4)

HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

NORTHEAST UTILITIES

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until June 25 to request a hearing on a proposal by Northeast Utilities (NU), a registered holding company, and its subsidiaries, Western Massachusetts Electric Company, The Quinnehtuk Company, Connecticut Light and Power Company, Northeast Utilities Service Company, Northeast Nuclear Energy Company, The Rocky River Realty Company and Holyoke Water Power Company to establish a system money pool to sell commercial paper and notes to banks from time to time through December 31, 1986. NU will also make capital contributions and open account advances to its subsidiaries. (Rel. 35-23714 - June 3)

AMERICAN ELECTRIC POWER COMPANY, INC.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until June 27 to request a hearing on a proposal by American Electric Power Company, Inc., a registered holding company, to extend, until June 30, 1986, the period during which it may issue and sell common stock under its dividend reinvestment and stock purchase plan. (Rel. 35-23716 - June 3)

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Commission approved, on an accelerated basis, proposed rule changes filed by the Chicago Board Options Exchange, Incorporated and the American, New York, Pacific and Philadelphia Stock Exchanges. The rule changes (SR-CBOE-85-3; SR-PSE-85-9; SR-Amex-85-16; SR-Phlx-85-12; and SR-NYSE-85-20) will amend the exchanges' rules to allow for the implementation of a one-year pilot program using monthly instead of quarterly expiration cycles. In addition, the NYSE proposal includes an amendment to its rules regarding new options series, in conformity to the other exchanges' rules. (Rel. 34-22099)

NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The National Association of Securities Dealers, Inc. filed a proposed rule change under Rule 19b-4 (SR-NASD-85-12) to permit it to require any market maker, whose quotations appear to be no longer reasonably related to the prevailing market in a NASDAQ security, to re-enter its quotation. Publication of the proposal is expected to be made in the Federal Register during the week of June 3. (Rel. 34-22100)
