### COMMENTS REQUESTED ON PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO RULE 15c3-1 -- NET CAPITAL REQUIREMENTS FOR BROKERS AND DEALERS

The Commission proposes for public comment amendments to Securities Exchange Act Rule 15c3-1 that would expand the types of instruments that could be used to create hedged positions in highly rated corporate debt securities. The amendments would also lower the deduction from net worth in arriving at net capital for hedged corporate debt securities positions and would redefine the criteria for determining whether the maturities of two offsetting positions are close enough to consider the combined corporate debt securities position to be hedged. The net effect of the amendments would be to lower the restrictions on use of capital by those brokers or dealers that have significant offsetting positions in highly rated corporate debt securities.

## CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

---

### WOODFORD CHAPMAN, OTHERS ENJOINED

The Boston Regional Office announced that on October 2 Judge Martin F. Loughlin entered an Order of Permanent Injunction against Woodford Chapman of Windham, New Hampshire, Stephen Peabody and Secured Lending Associates, Inc. (SLA), both of Nashua, New Hampshire. The Order enjoins them from violations of the registration and antifraud provisions of the Securities Act of 1933 and the antifraud provisions of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rule 10b-5. Chapman, Peabody and SLA consented to the Order without admitting or denying the complaint's allegations.

The July 10 complaint alleges that the SLA prospectus, prepared by the defendants, contained numerous material misrepresentations and omissions. Specifically, the complaint alleges that: the purported Chairman of SLA's Finance Committee was, in fact, never involved with SLA's business; the SLA prospectus failed to disclose a November 1984 Cease and Desist Order issued against SLA by the State of Massachusetts; and the SLA prospectus did not disclose that Halifax Corporation, an entity owned by Chapman and managed by Peabody, received more than \$150,000 in financing from SLA. Additionally, the complaint alleged that the defendants sold unregistered securities, namely promissory notes and investment contracts, to investors in Massachusetts and New Hampshire and raised approximately \$300,000.
